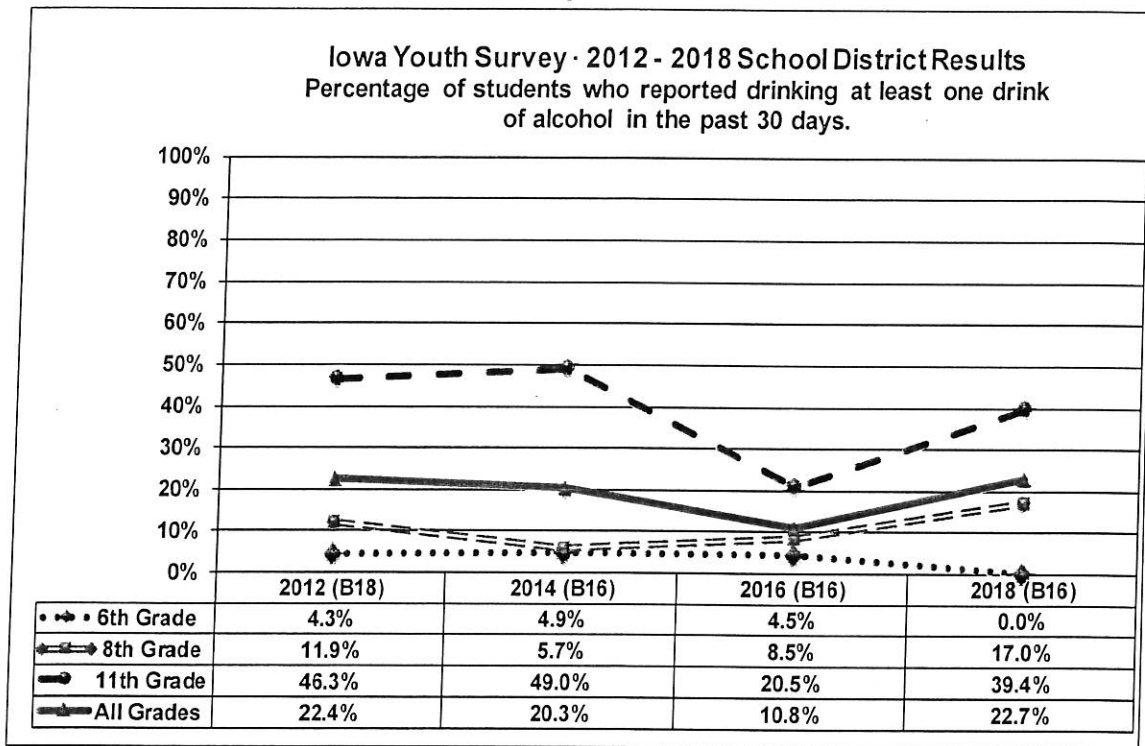

Figure 2. Alcohol Use in Past 30 Days



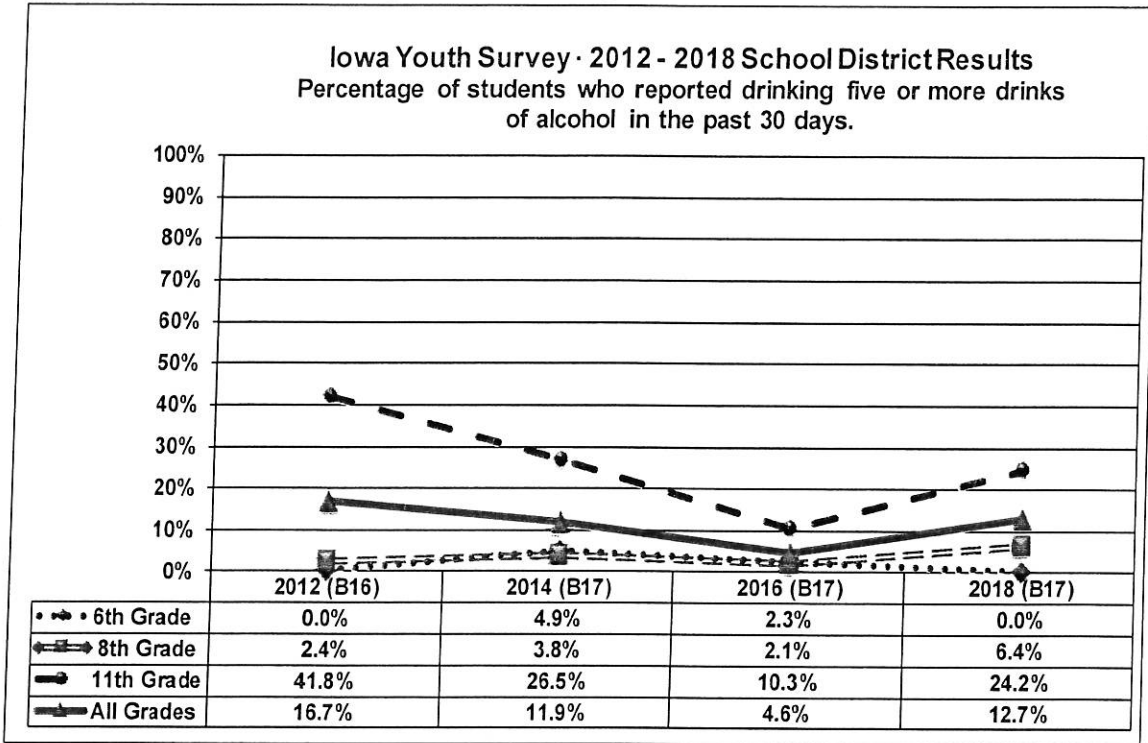

Figure 3. Binge Drinking in Past 30 Days



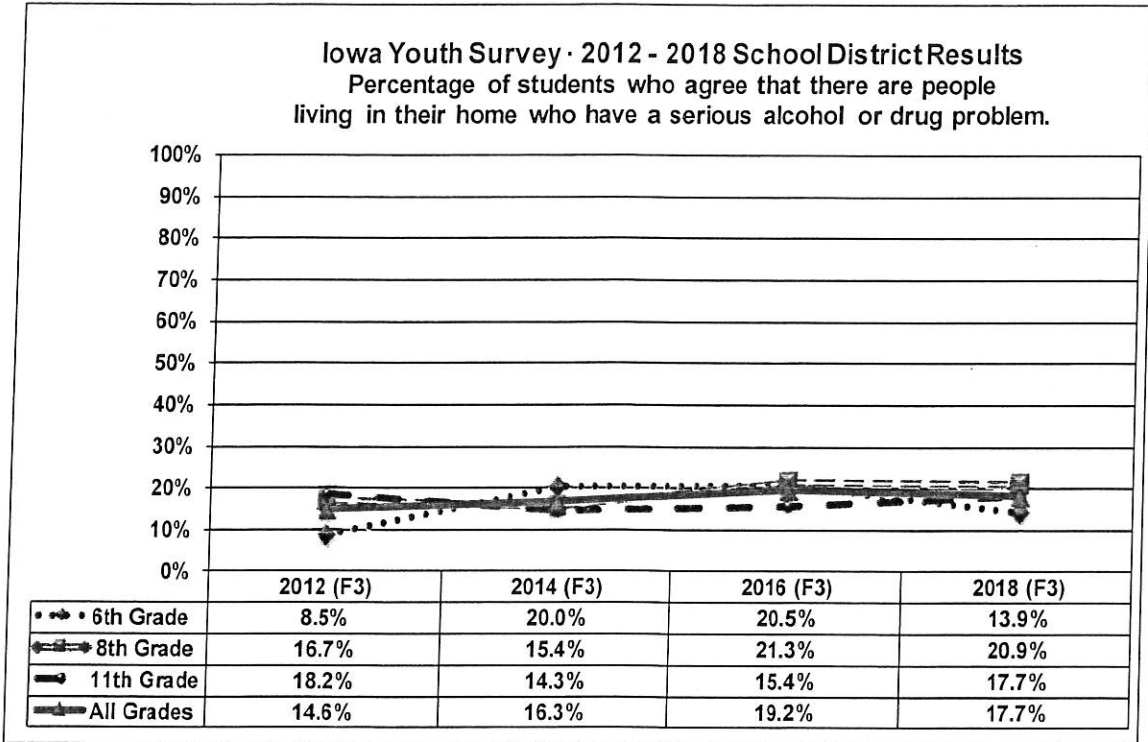

Figure 23. Students Have People in Their Home with Serious Alcohol or Drug Problem



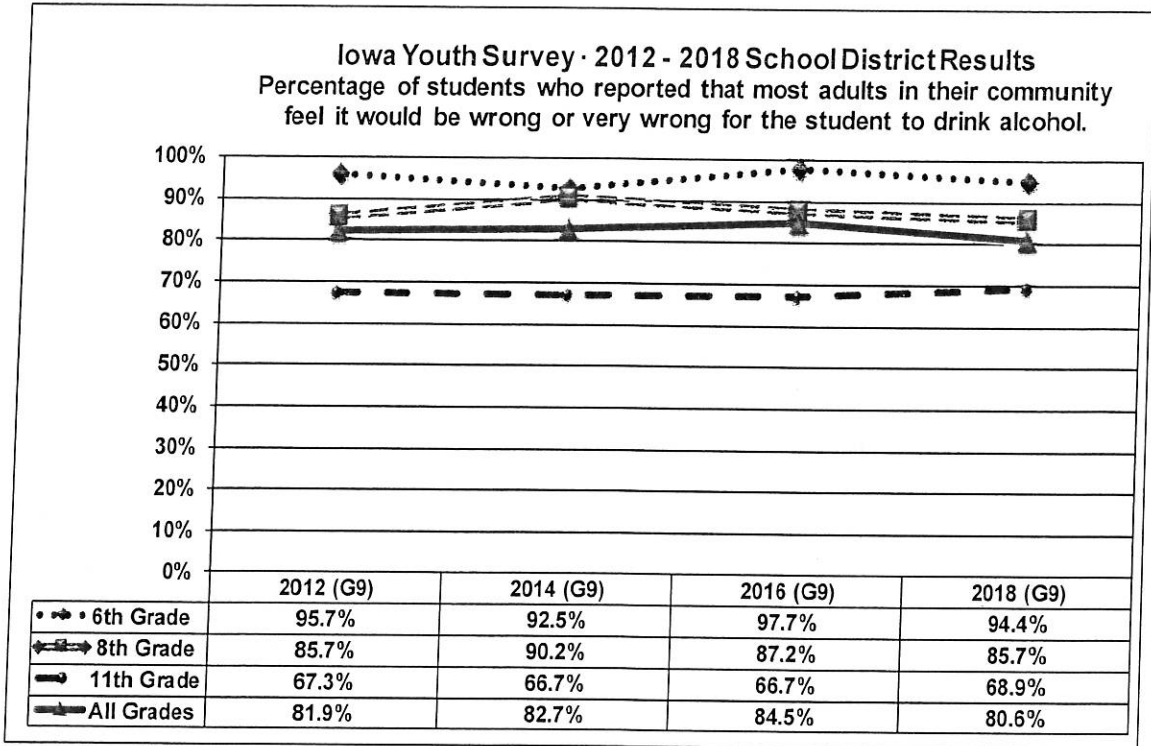

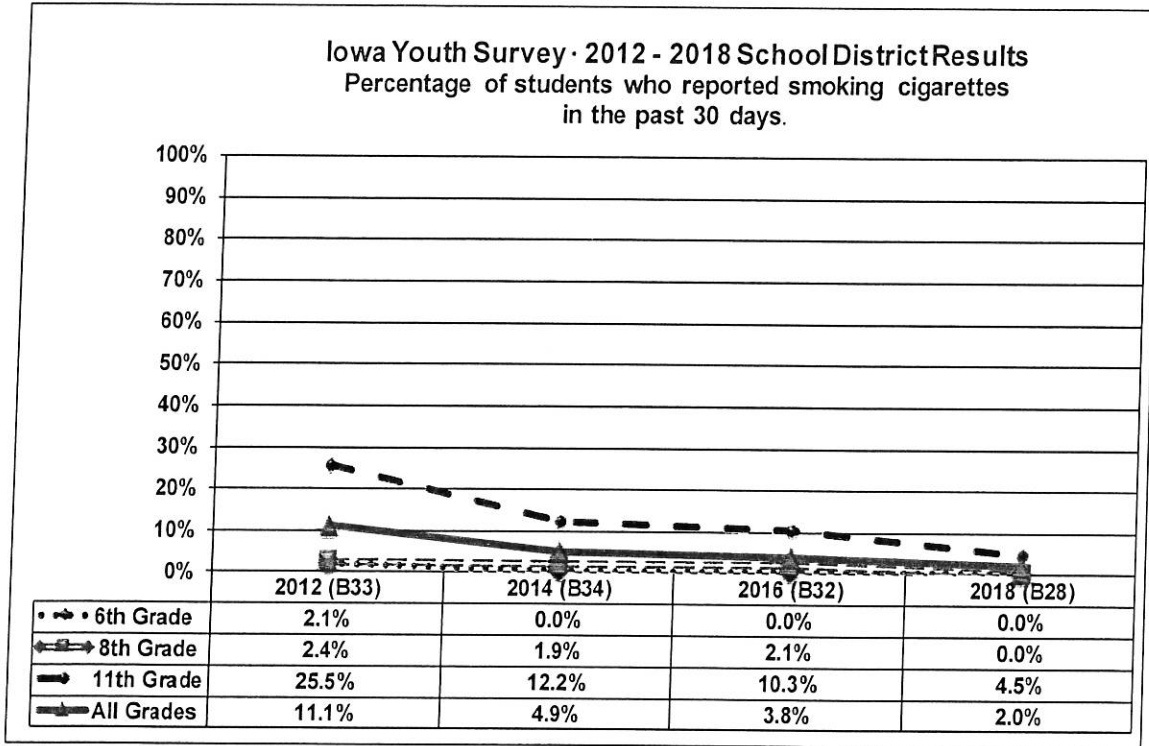

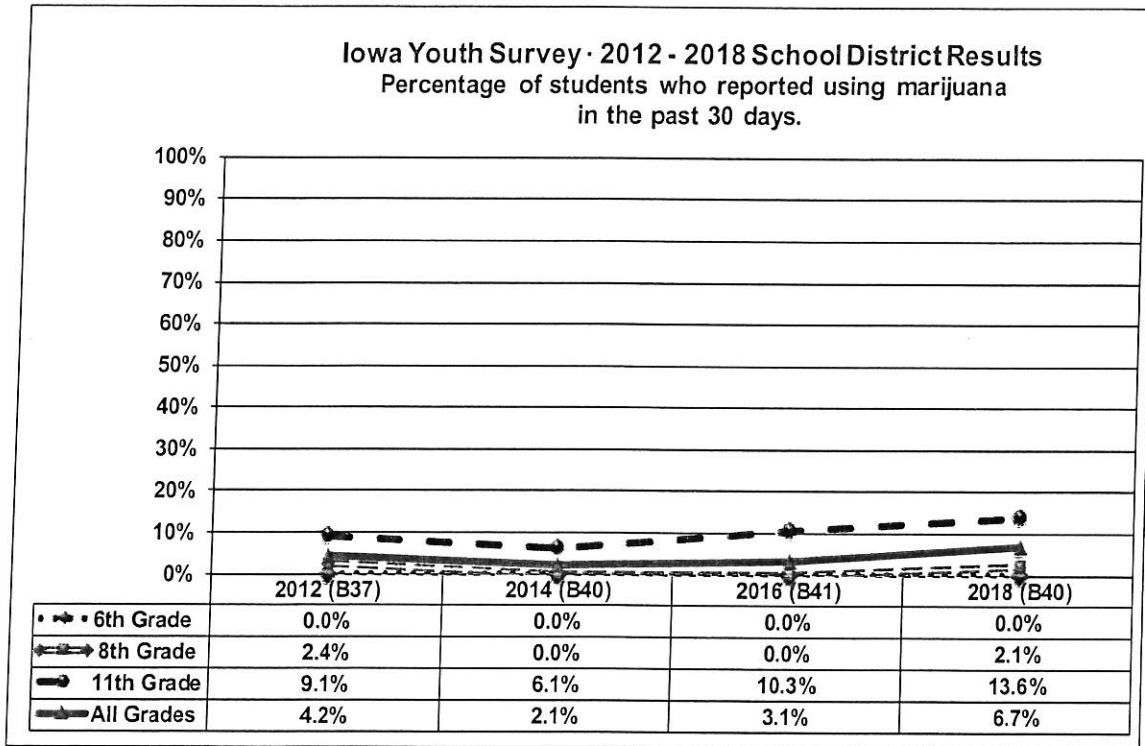

Figure 6. Marijuana Use in Past 30 Days



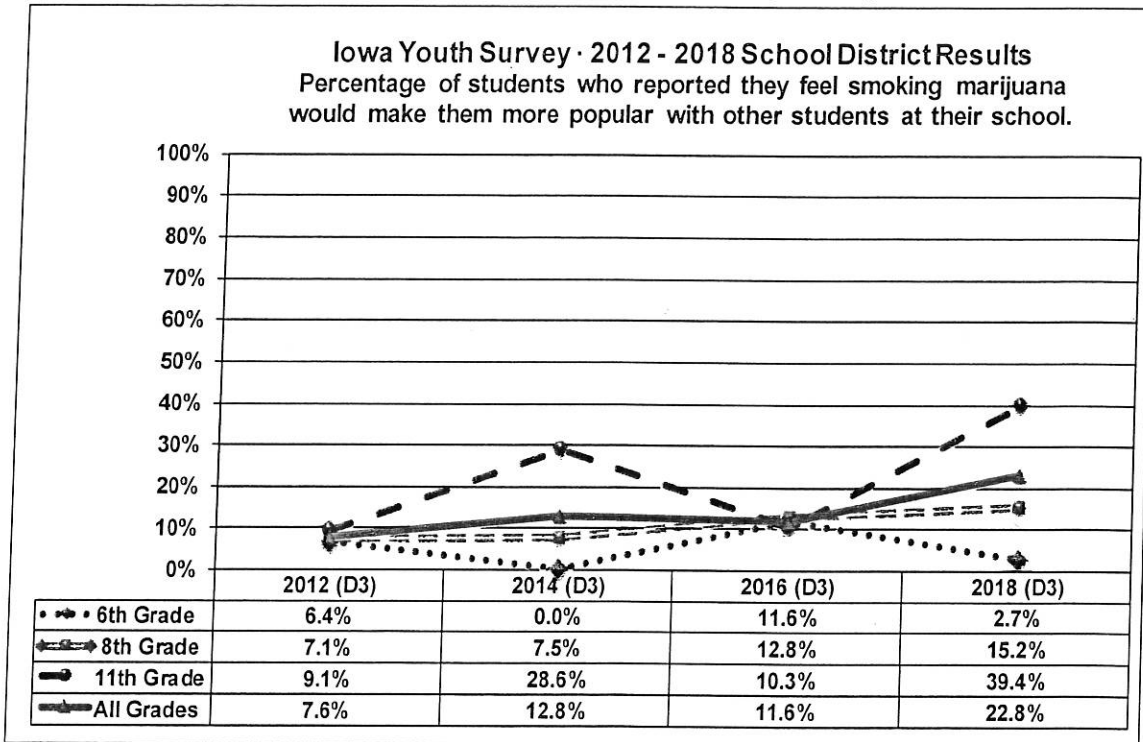

Figure 14. Smoking Marijuana Would Increase Popularity



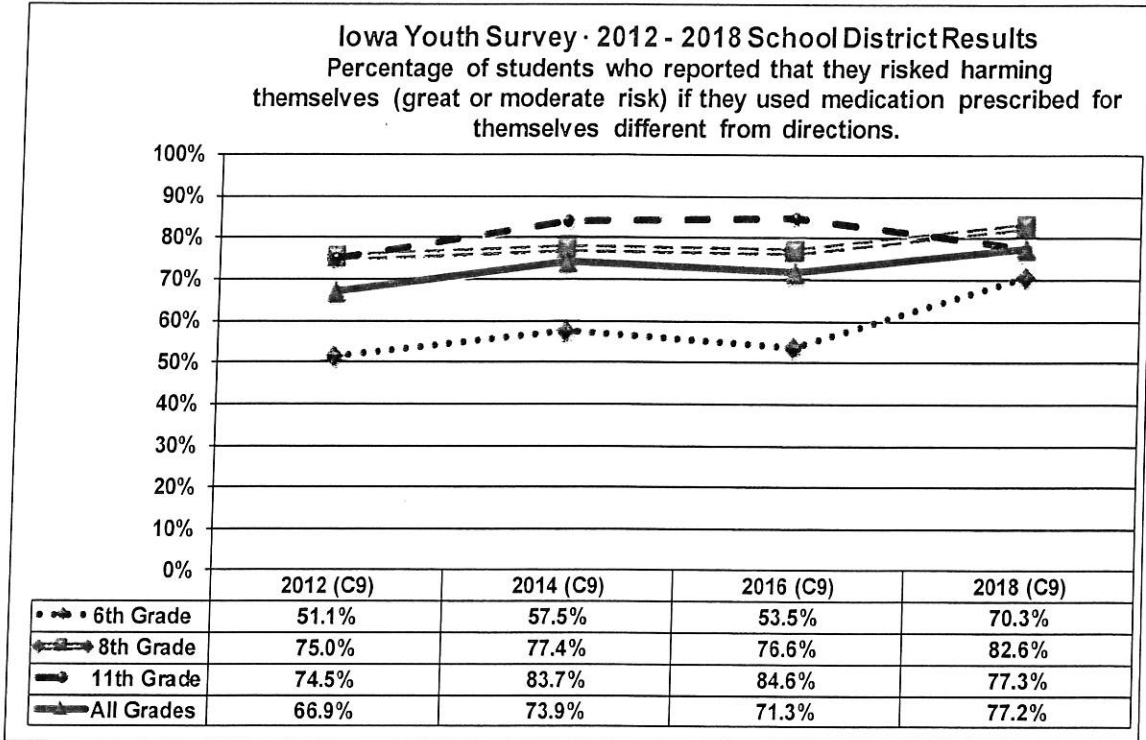

Figure 12. Risk of Using Medications Prescribed for Self Differently from Directions



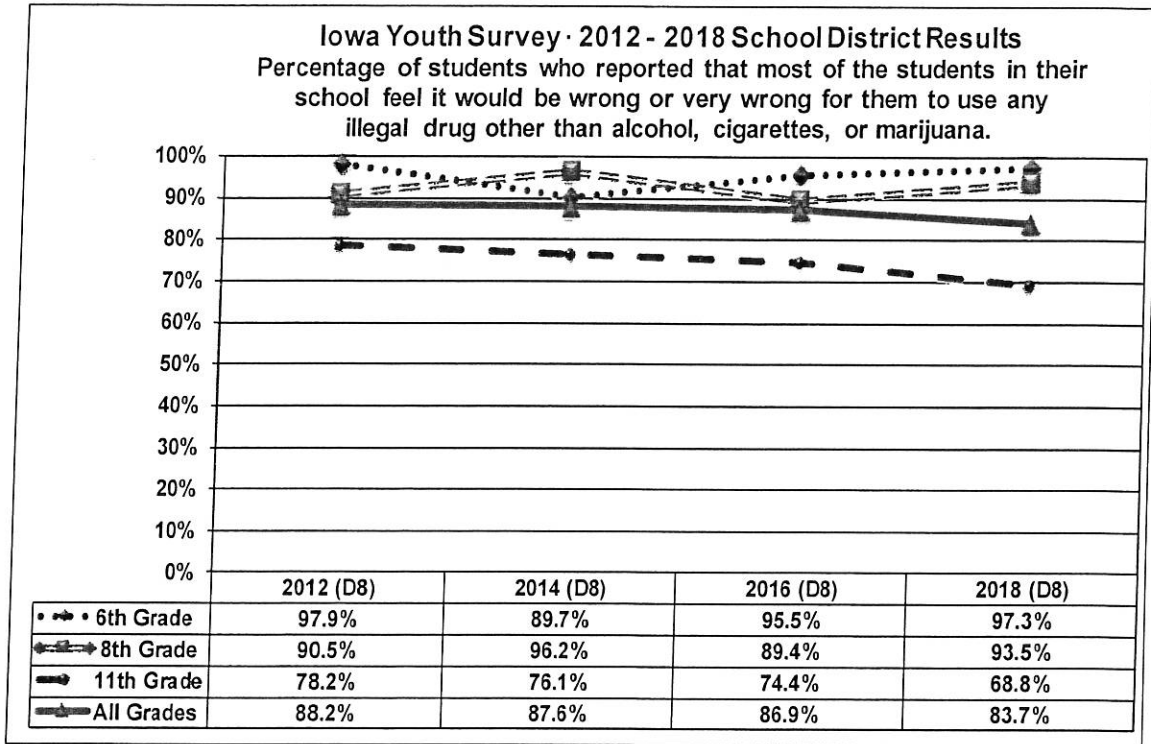

Figure 15. Other Students' Perceptions of Illegal Drug Use



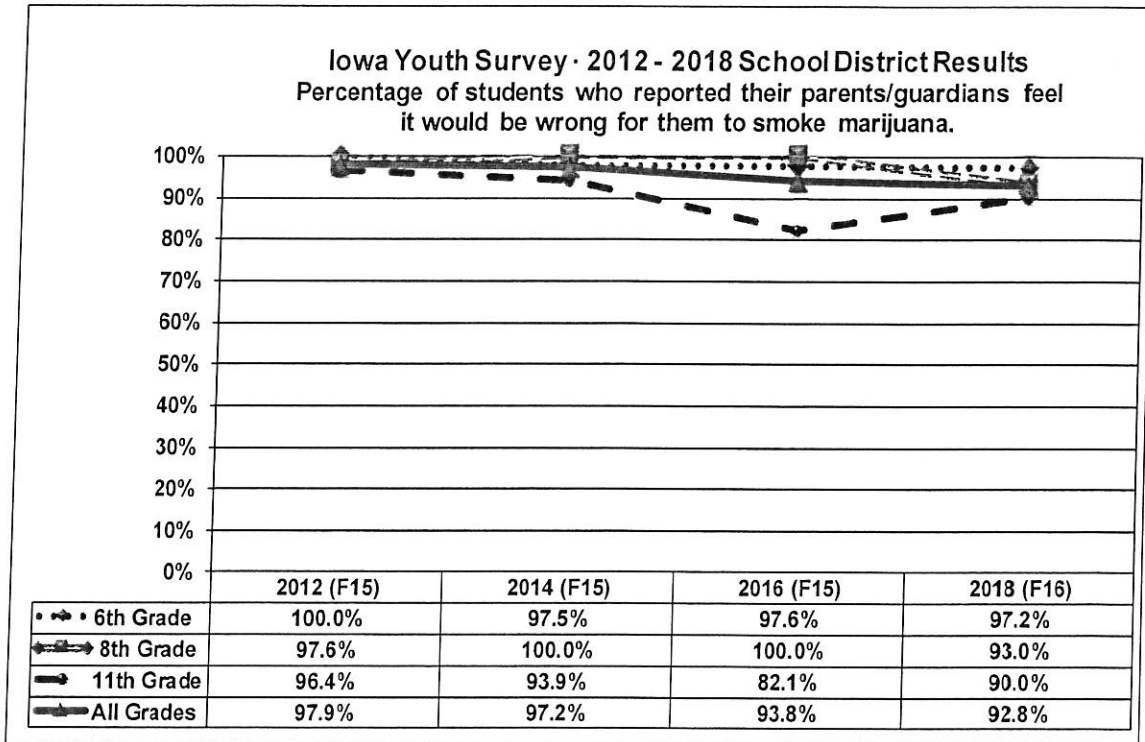

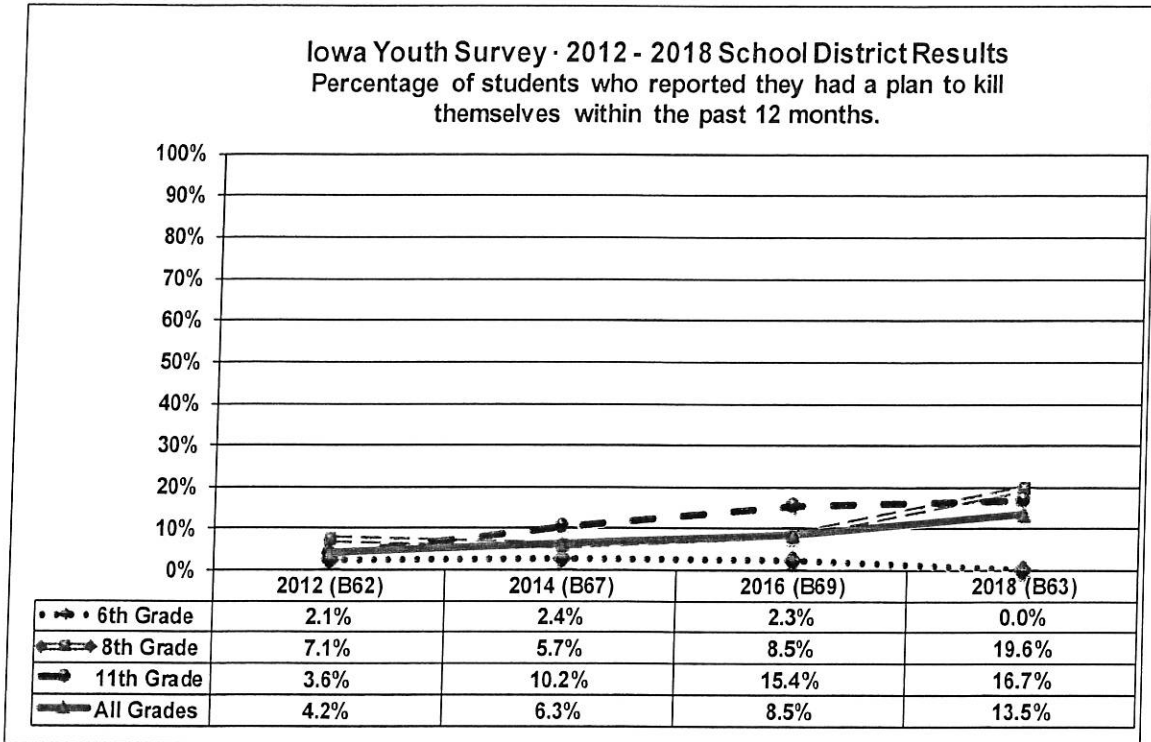

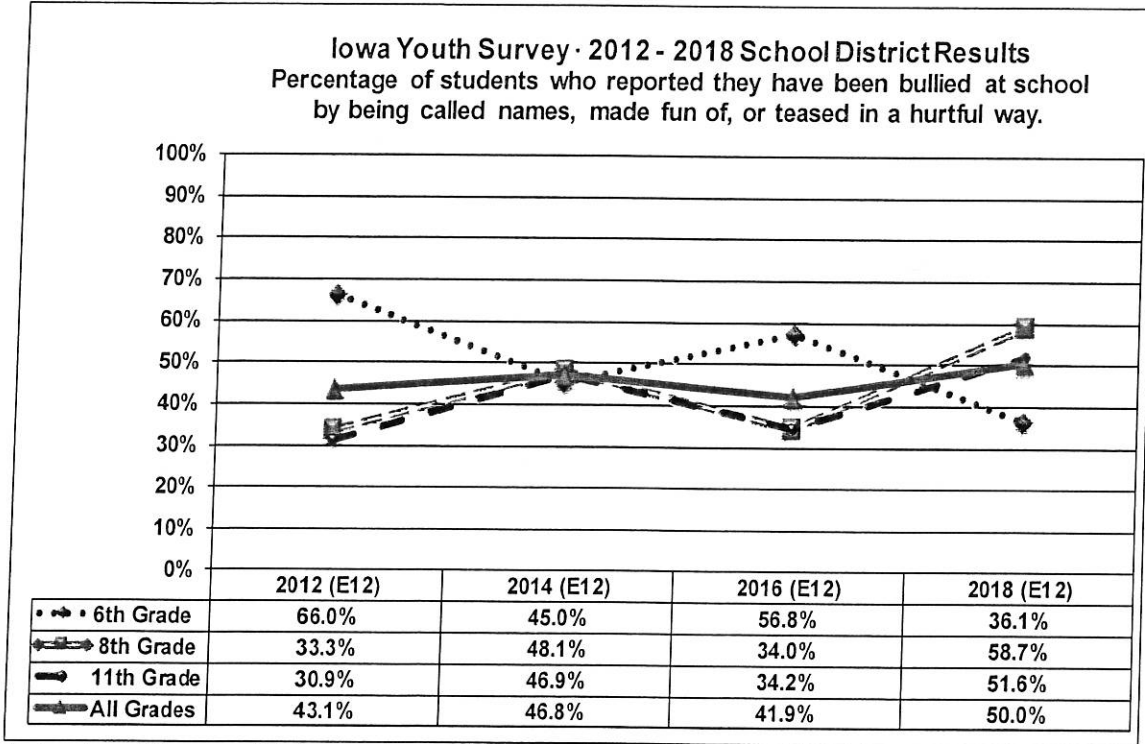

Figure 16. Bullying at School in Past 30 Days



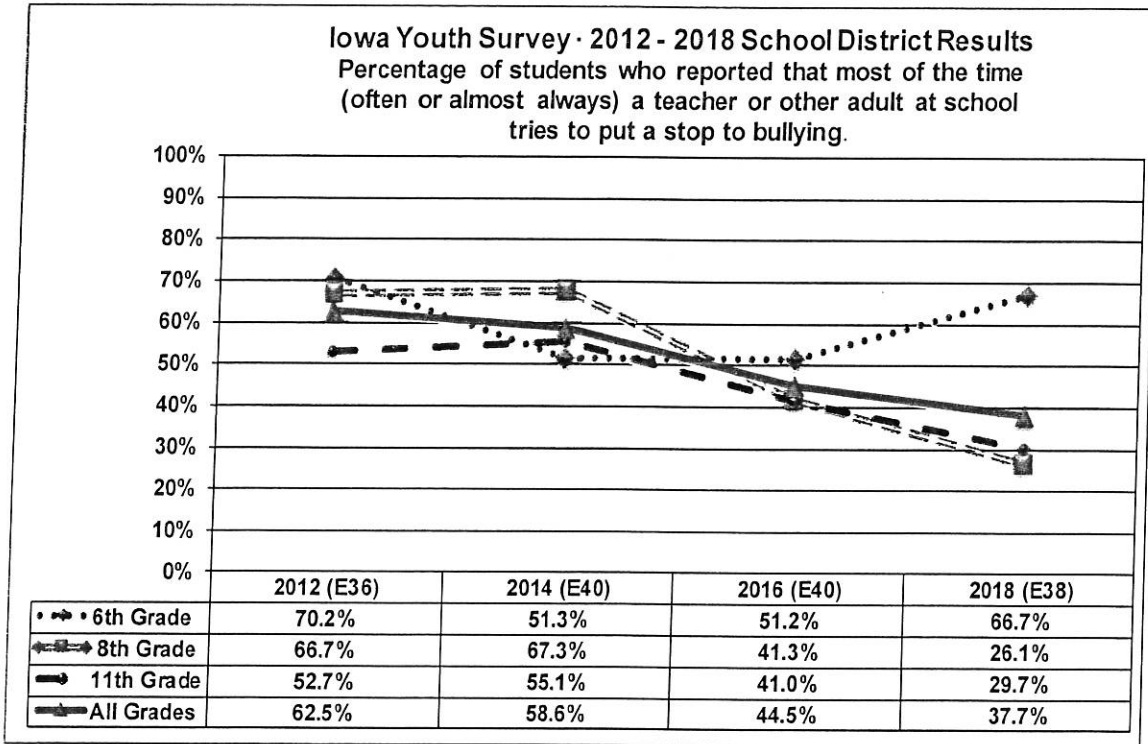

Figure 19. Teachers or Other Adults Put a Stop to Bullying at School



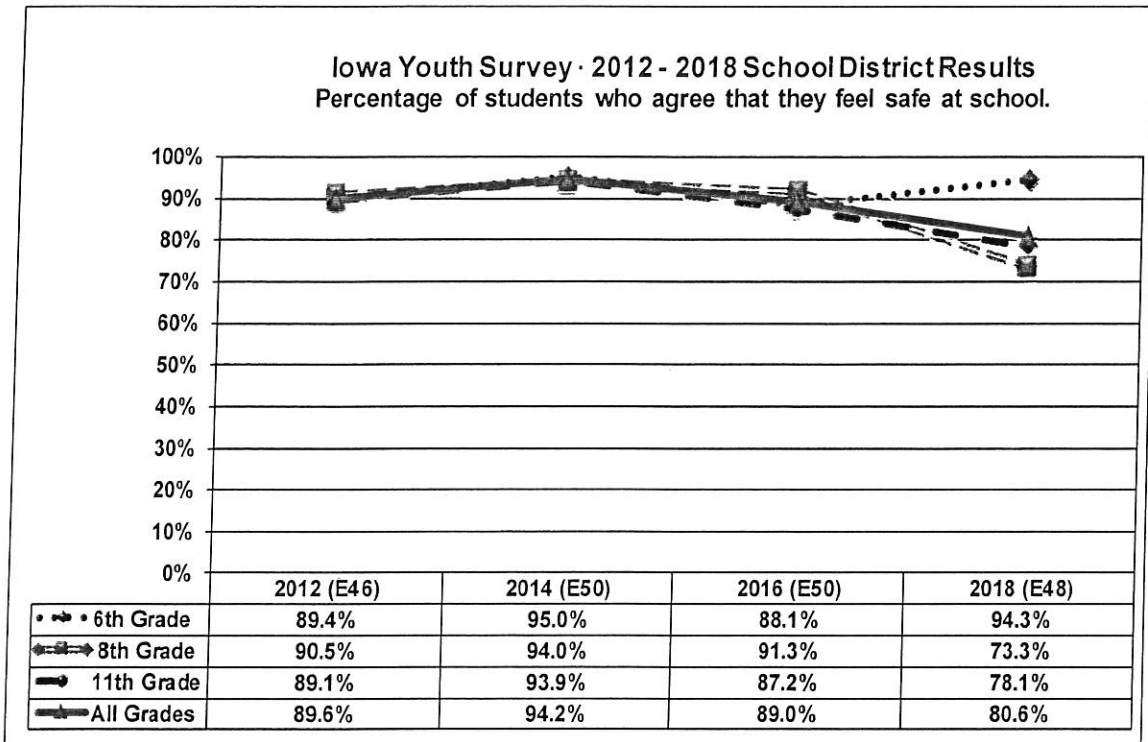

Figure 21. Students Feel Safe at School



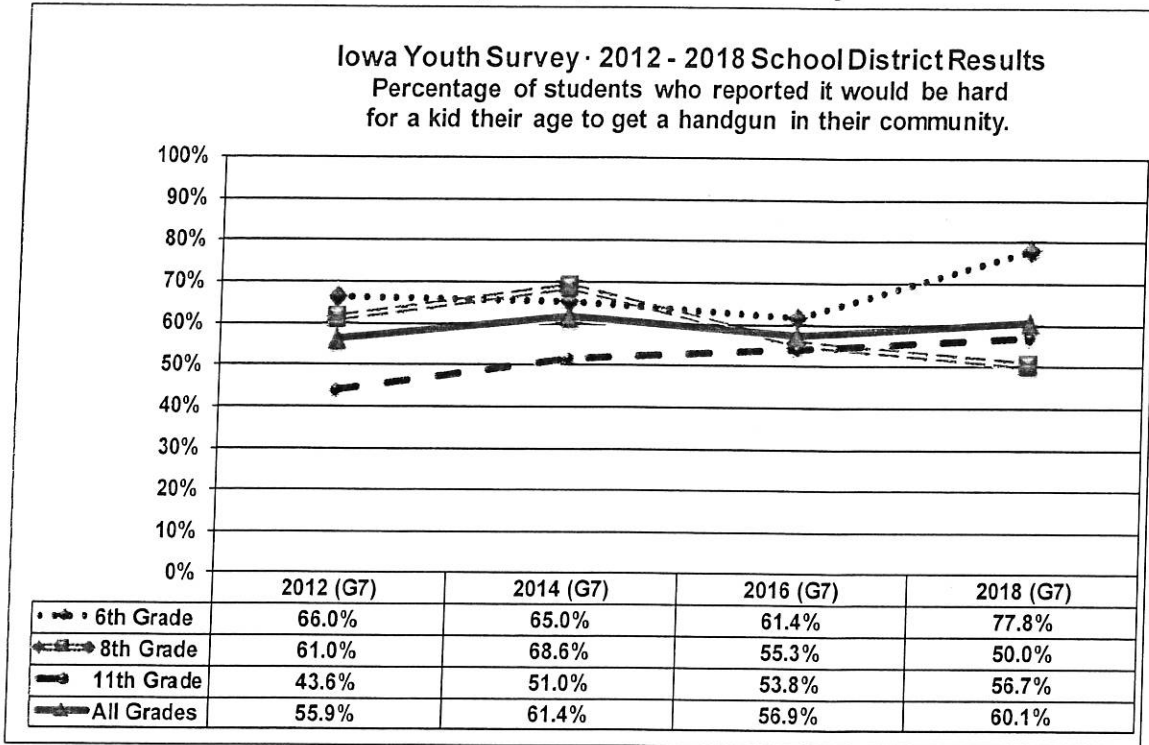

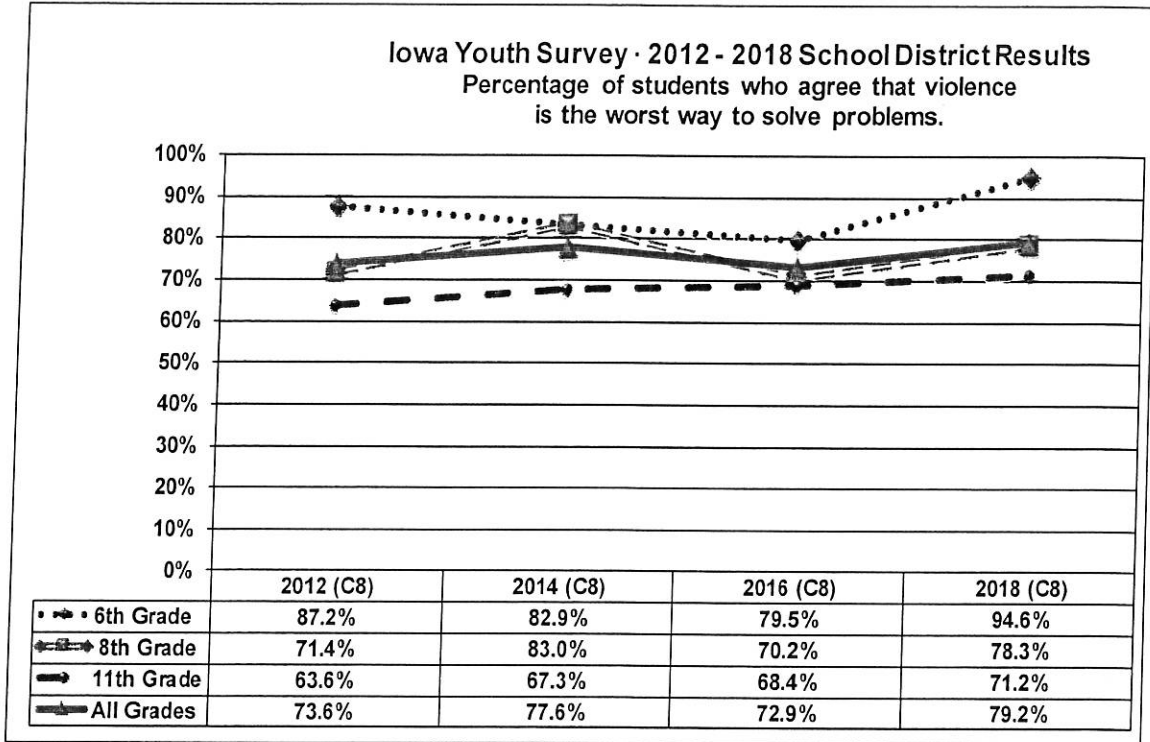

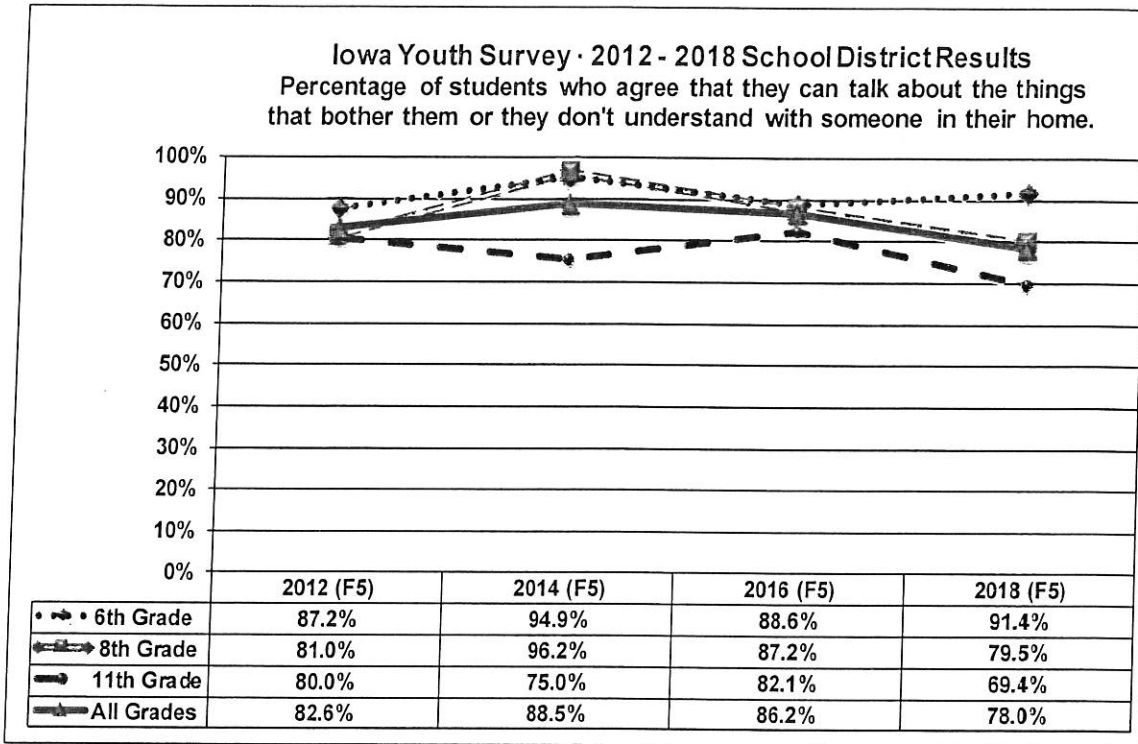

Figure 24. Students Have Someone They Can Talk With in Their Home



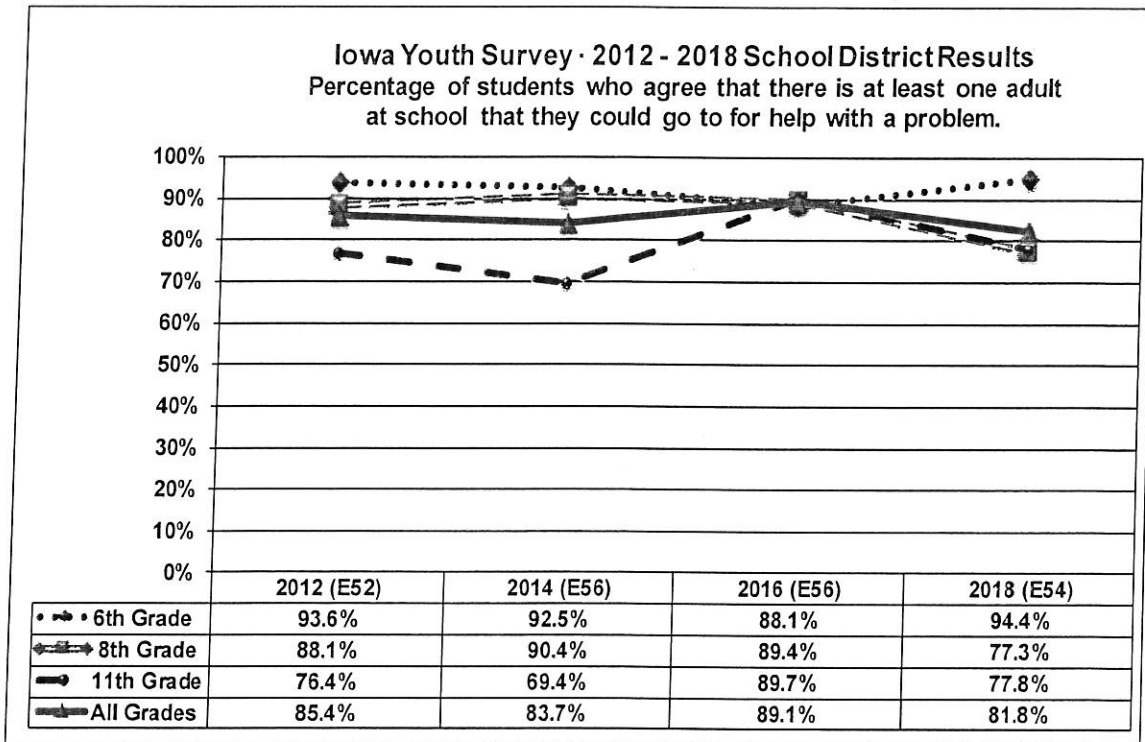

Figure 22. Students Have Adult at School to Go to for Help with Problems



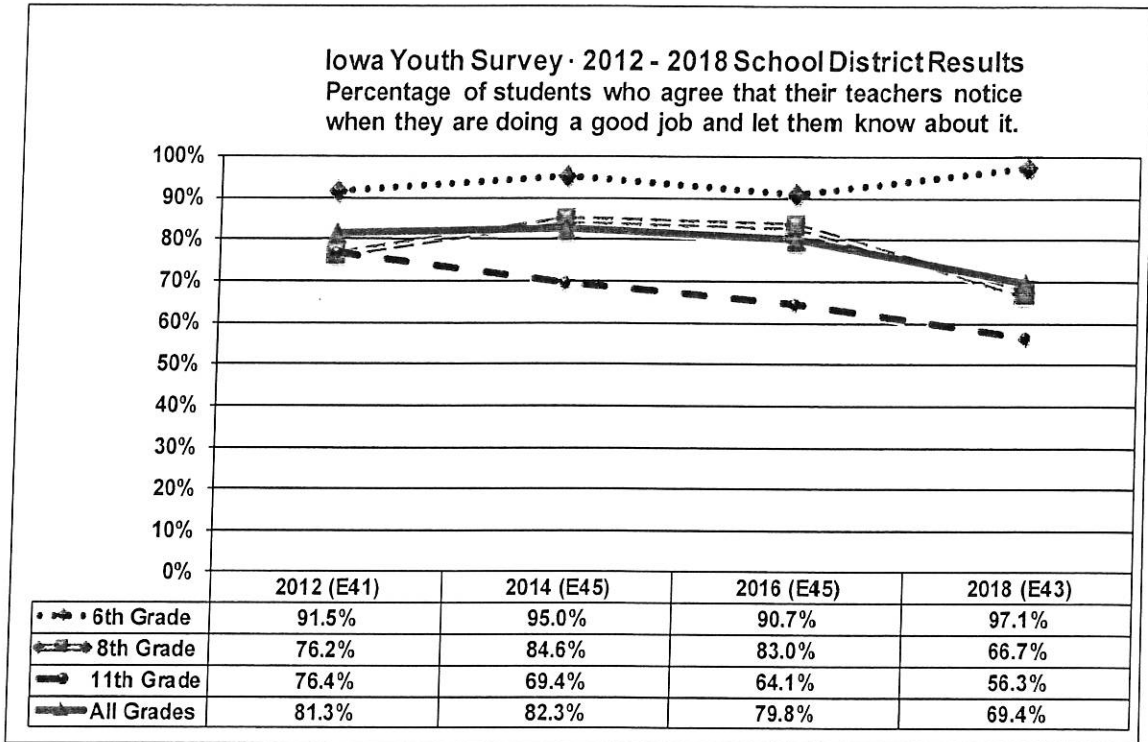

Figure 20. Teachers Notice and Let Students Know When They Are Doing a Good Job



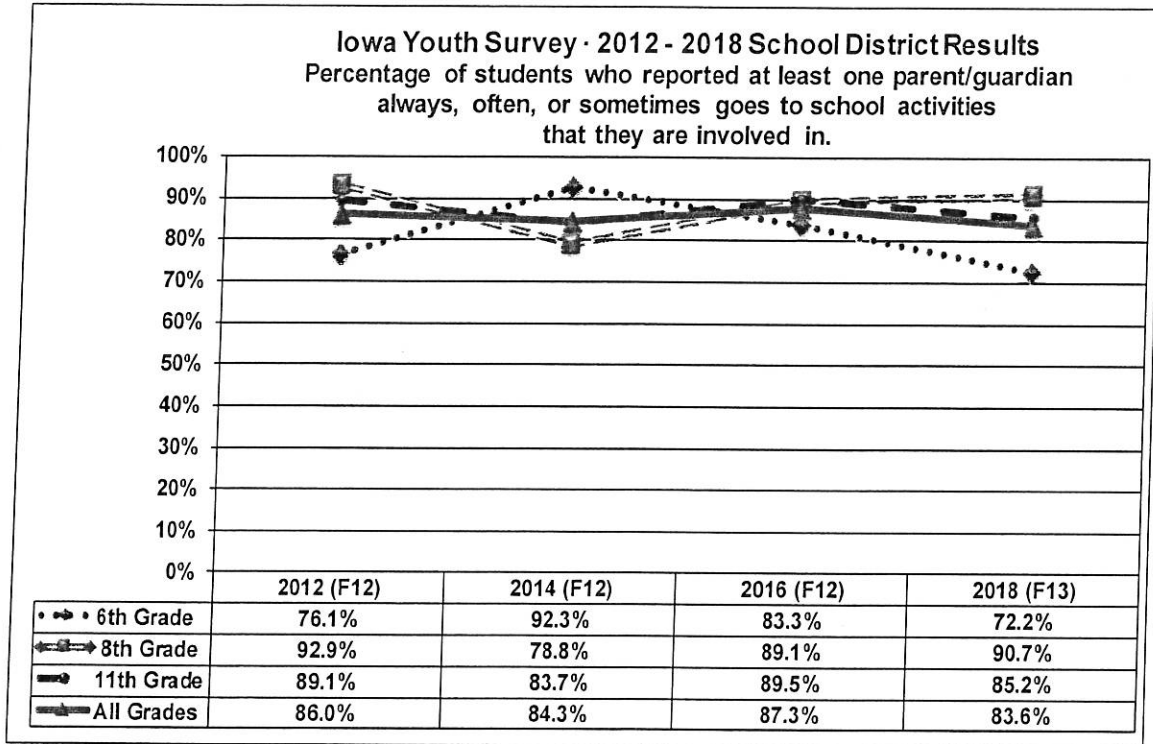

Figure 25. Parents/Guardians Attend School Activities



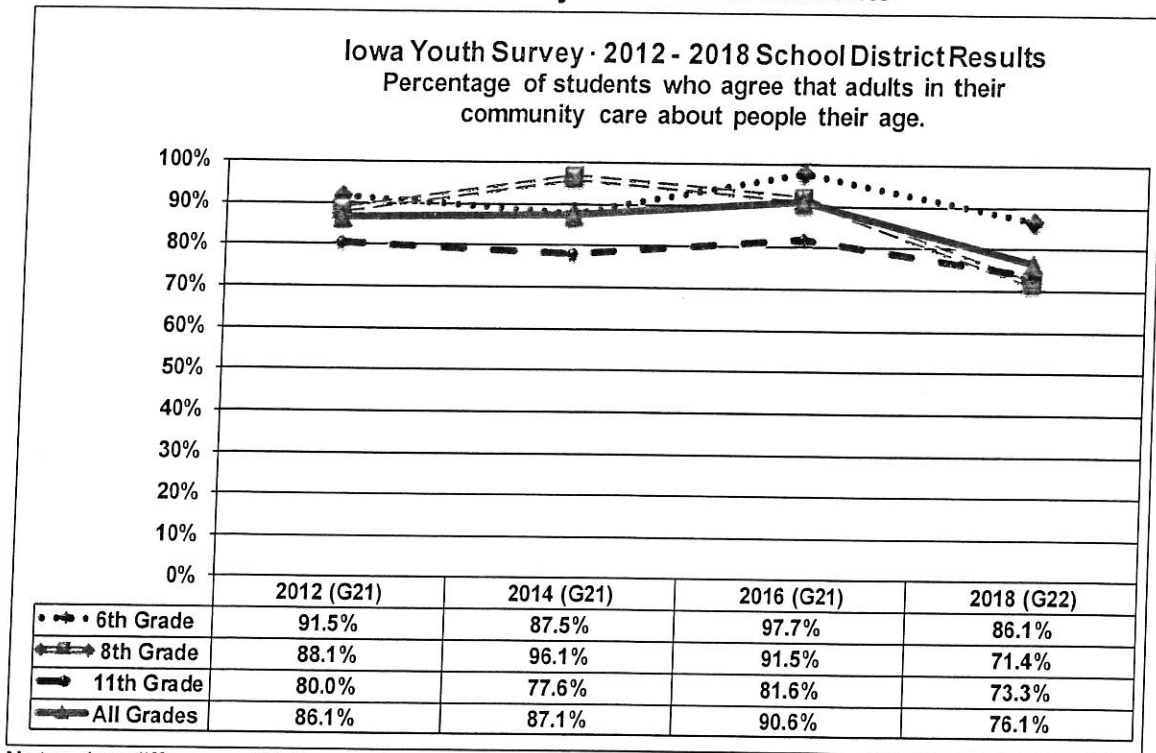

Figure 29. Adults in the Community Care About Students



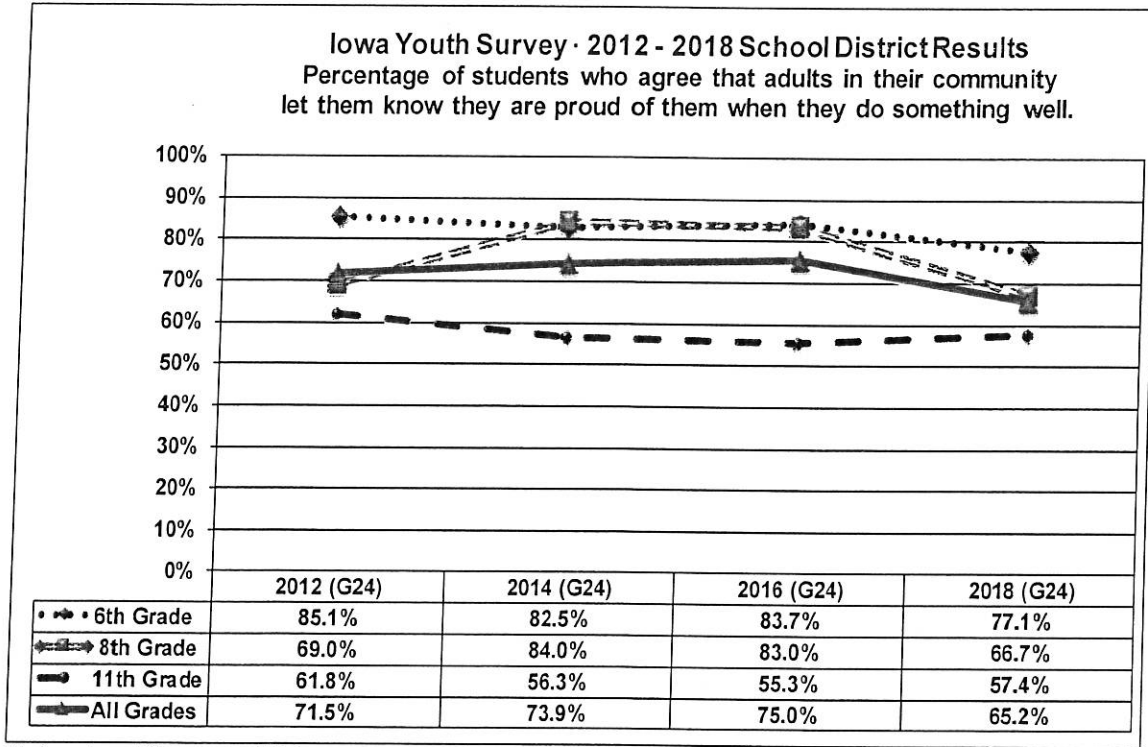

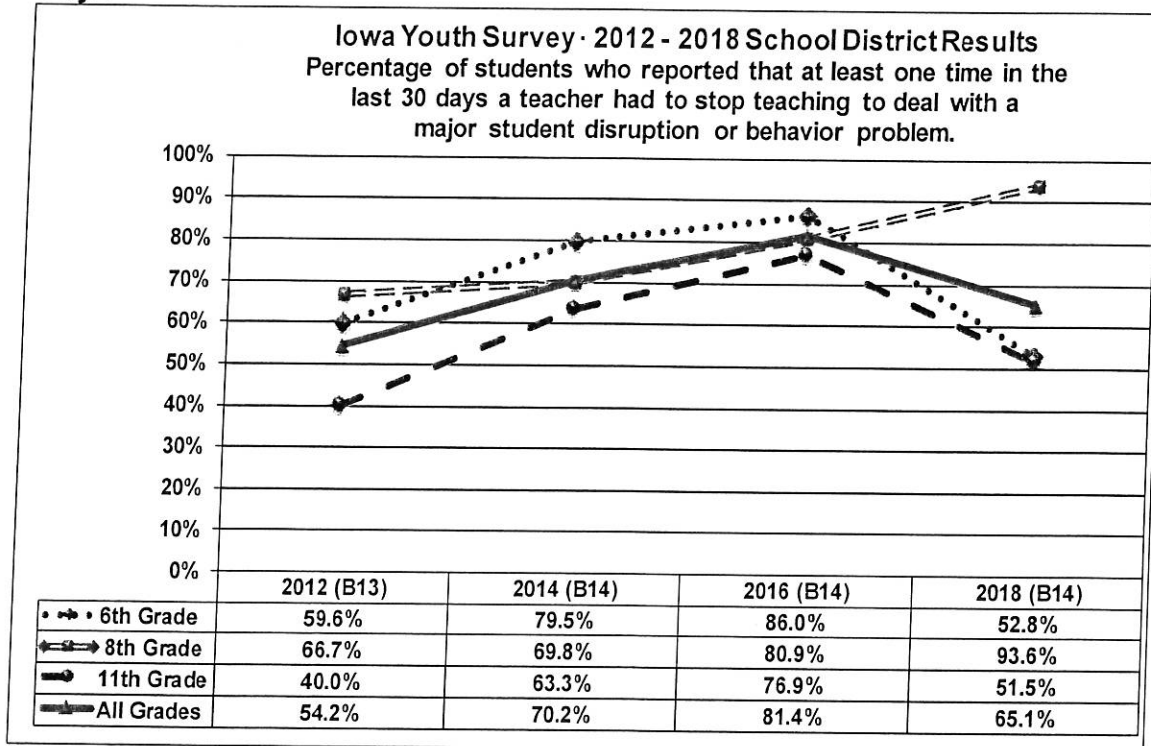

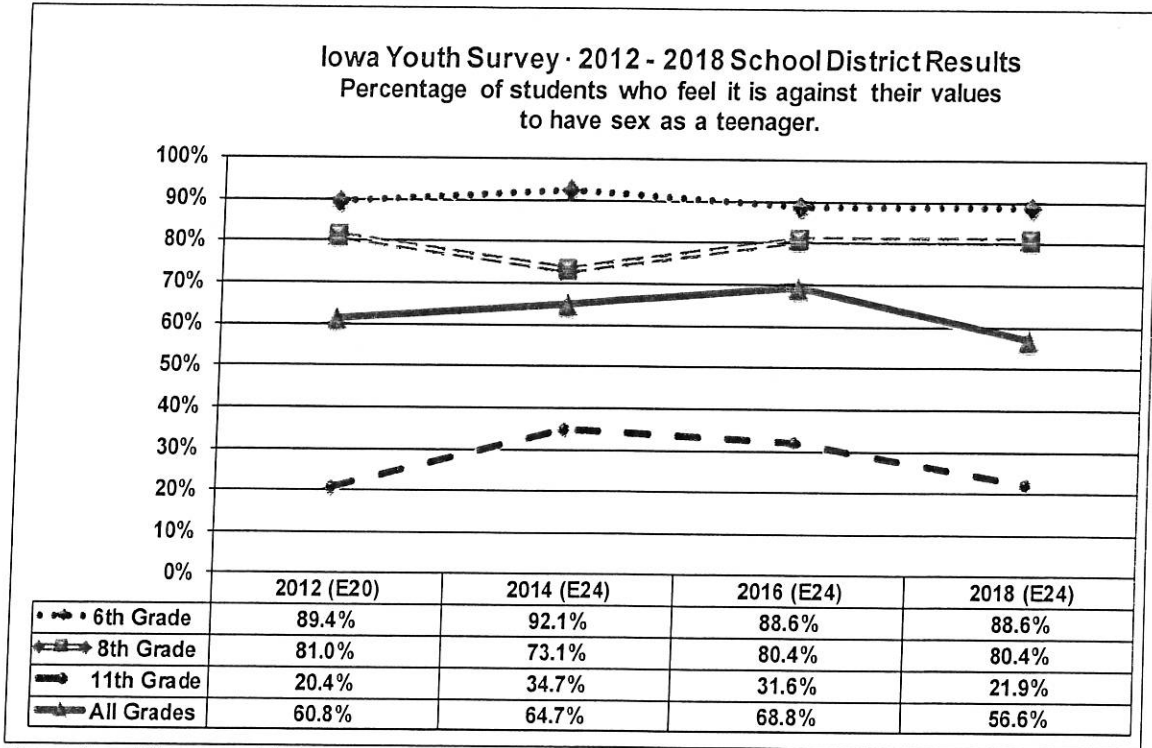

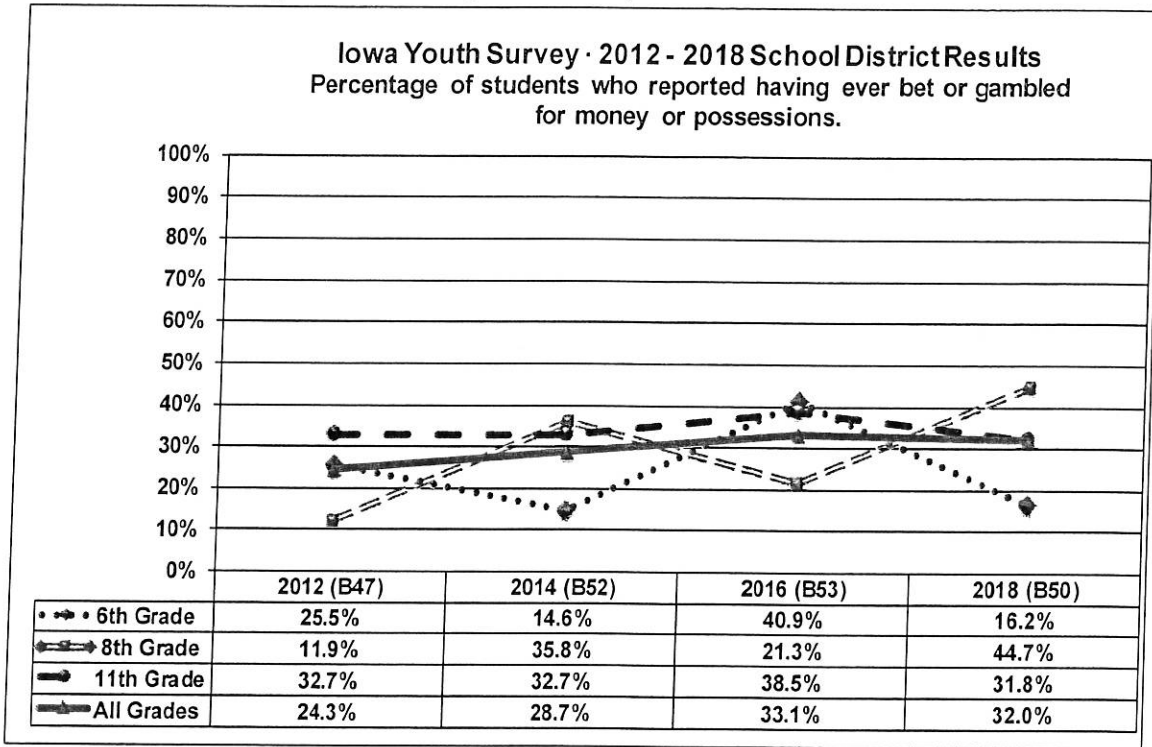

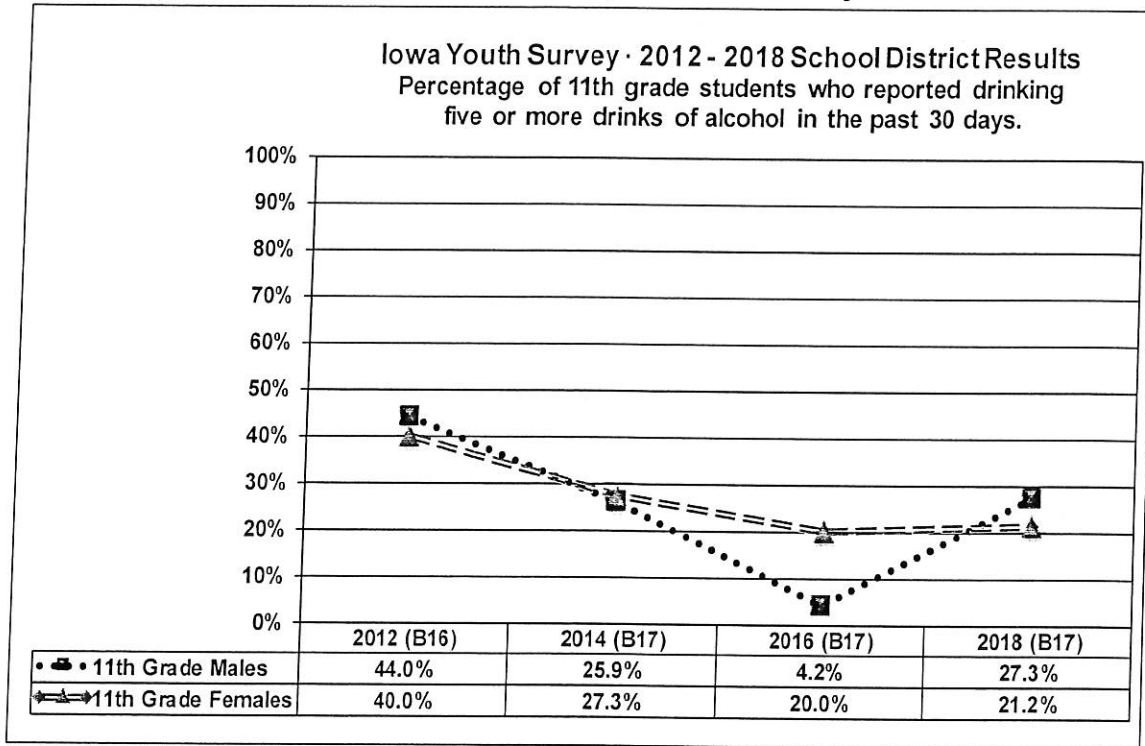

Figure 4. Binge Drinking in Past 30 Days: 11th Grade by Gender



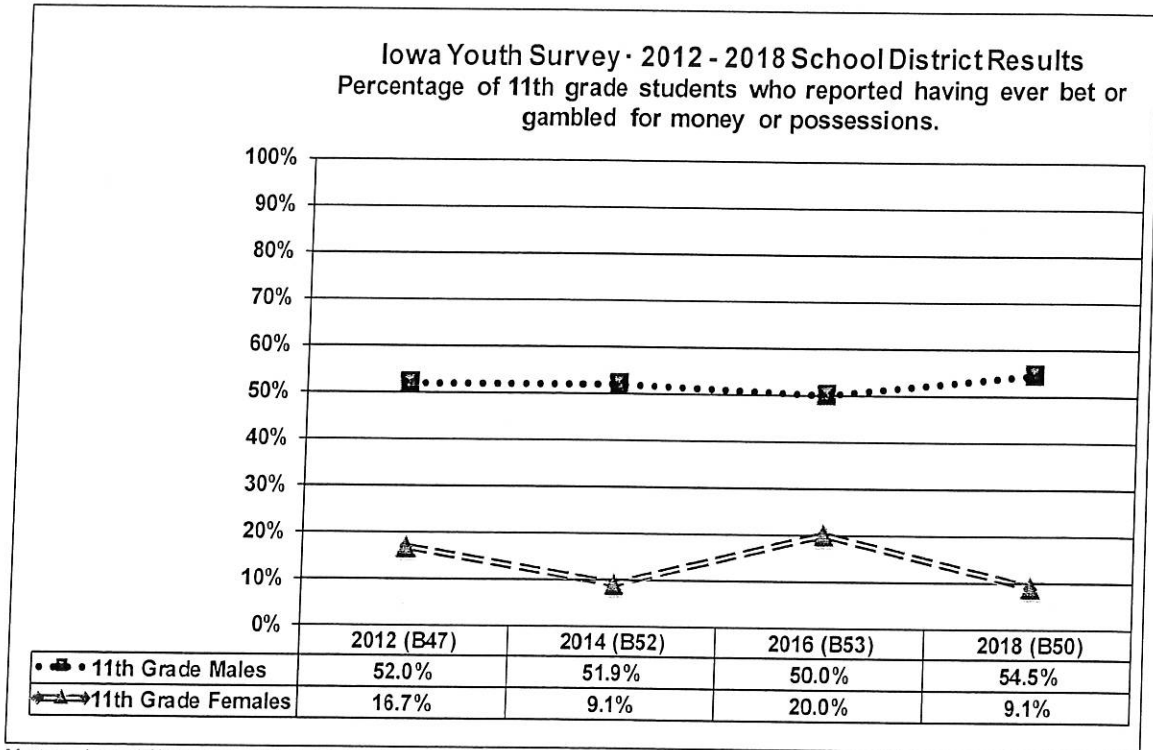

Figure 8. Betting or Gambling for Money or Possessions: 11th Grade by Gender



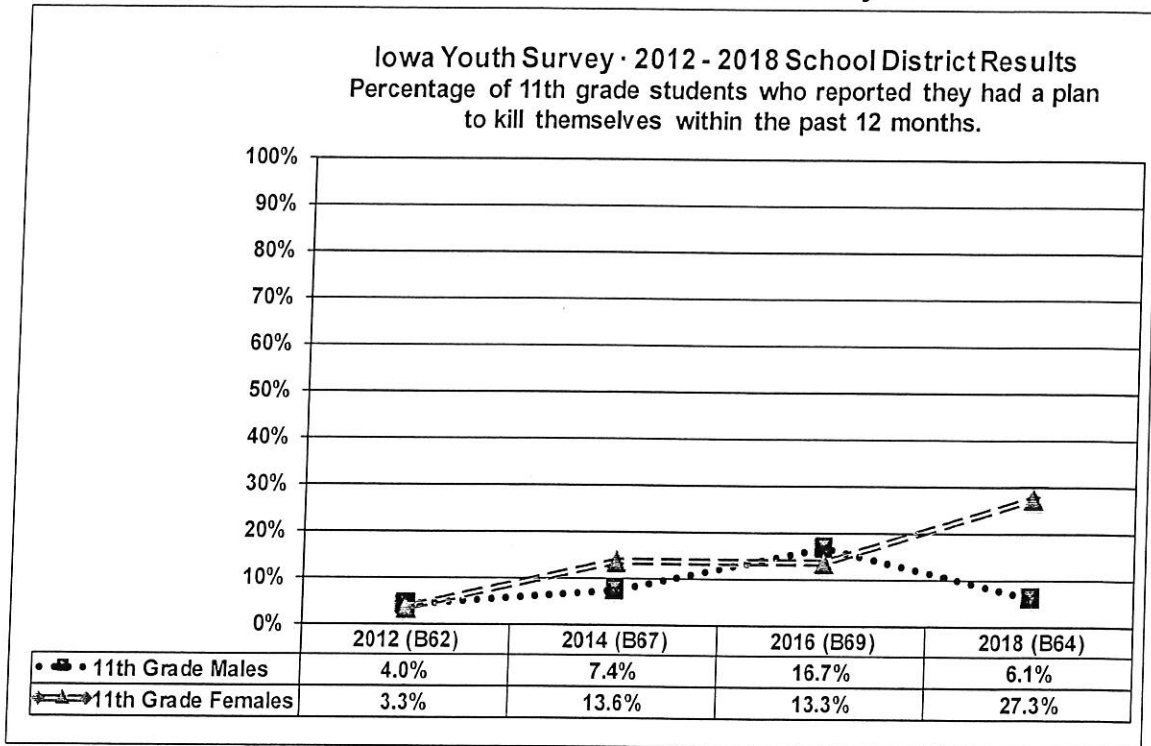

Figure 10. Suicide Plan in Past 12 Months: 11th Grade by Gender



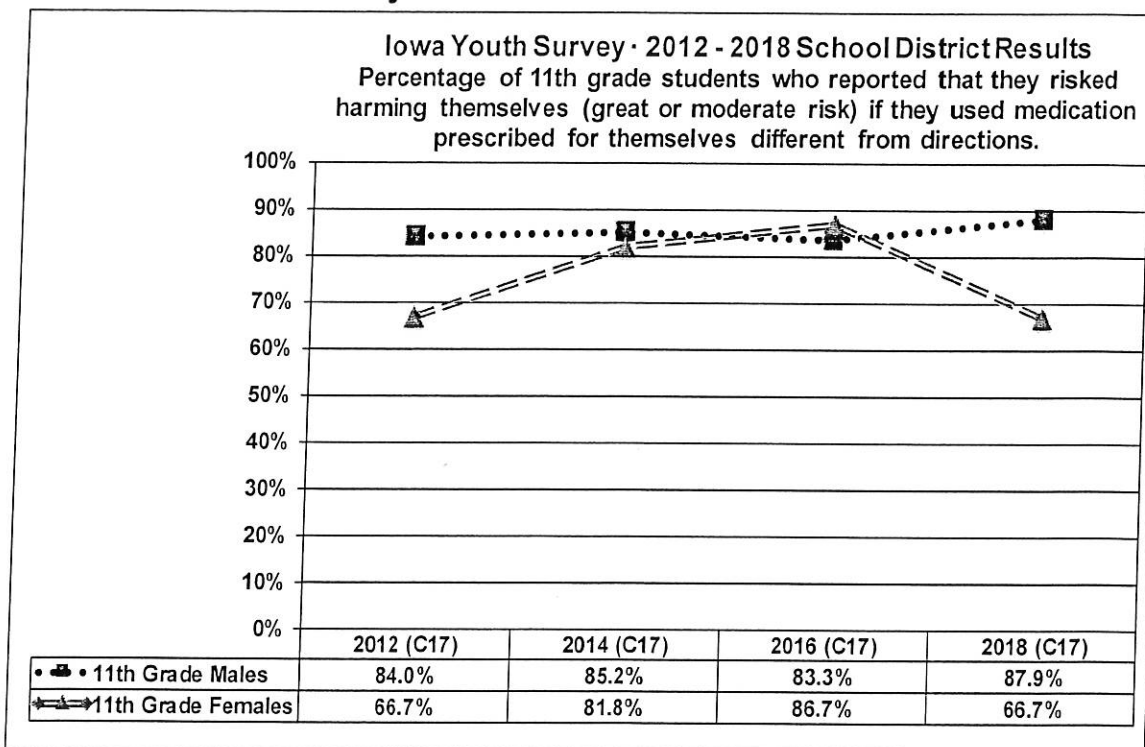

Figure 13. Risk of Using Medications Prescribed for Self Differently from Directions: 11th Grade by Gender



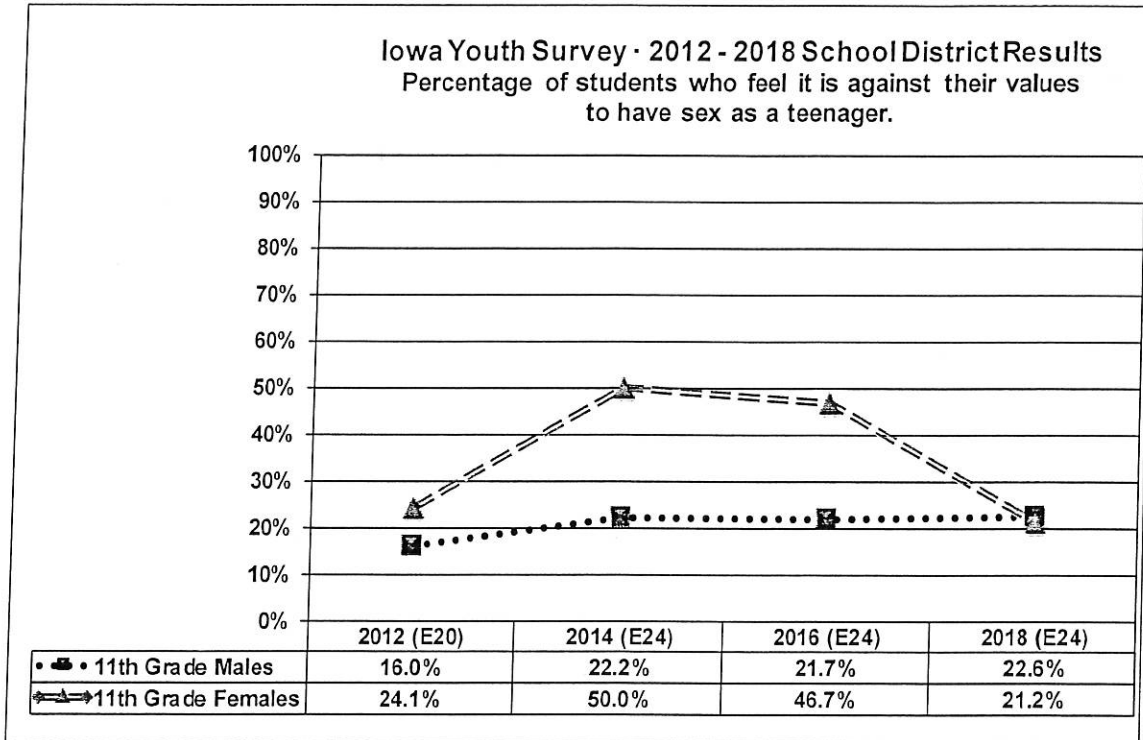
