


Q1 Please indicate the grade level of students you taught during the school closure this school year in the Bellevue CSD.


Q2 The district recognizes that student learning was impacted by the school closure. What was your satisfaction with the instruction you gave to students, along with the learning opportunities you provided to your students?




Q4 To your knowledge, did most of your students have internet access at home?


Q5 How often do you believe your student(s) worked on school work on average for your class (for those who participated)?


Q6 Do you believe it would have been more beneficial to meet with students on a daily basis online than what you did?


