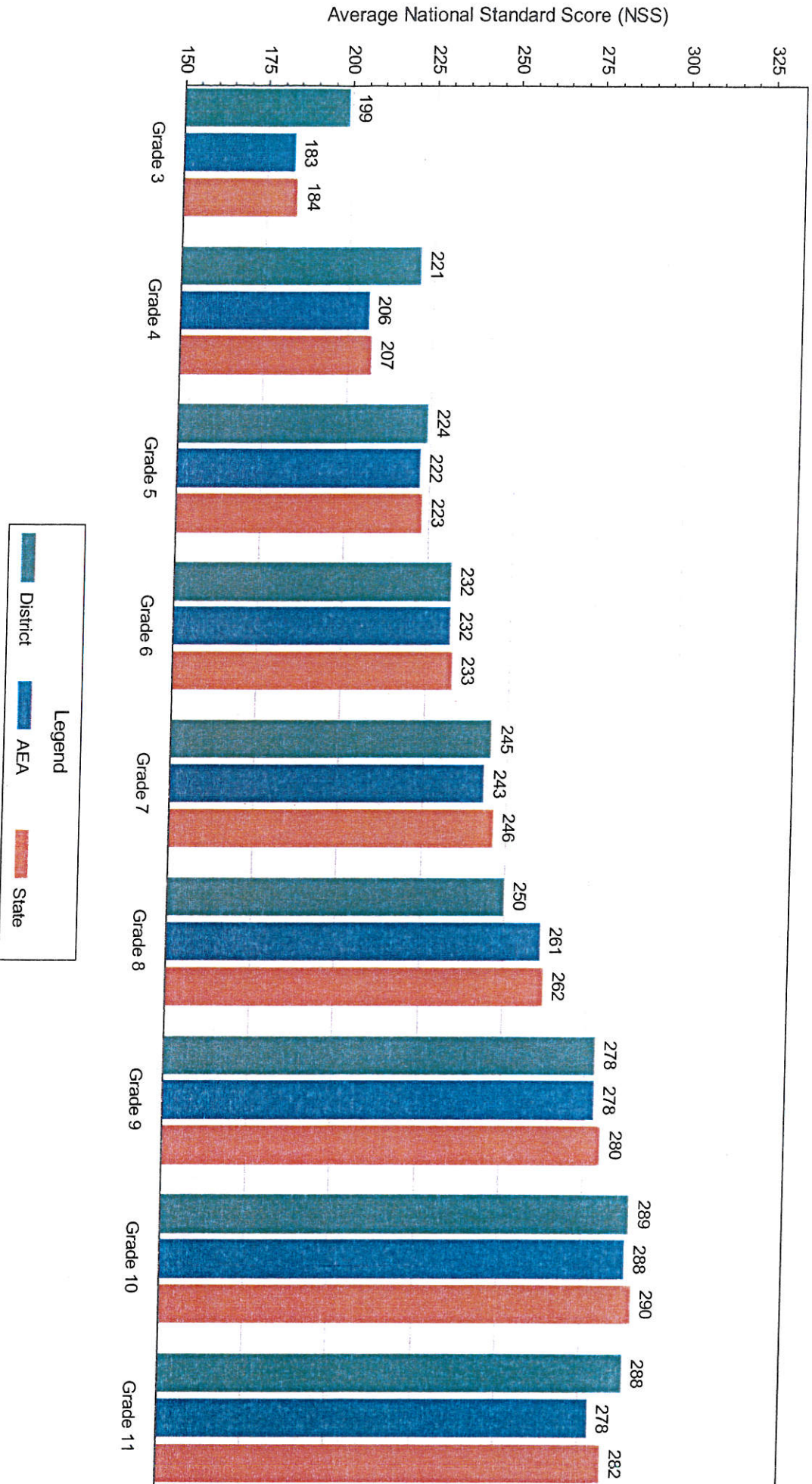

# Overview

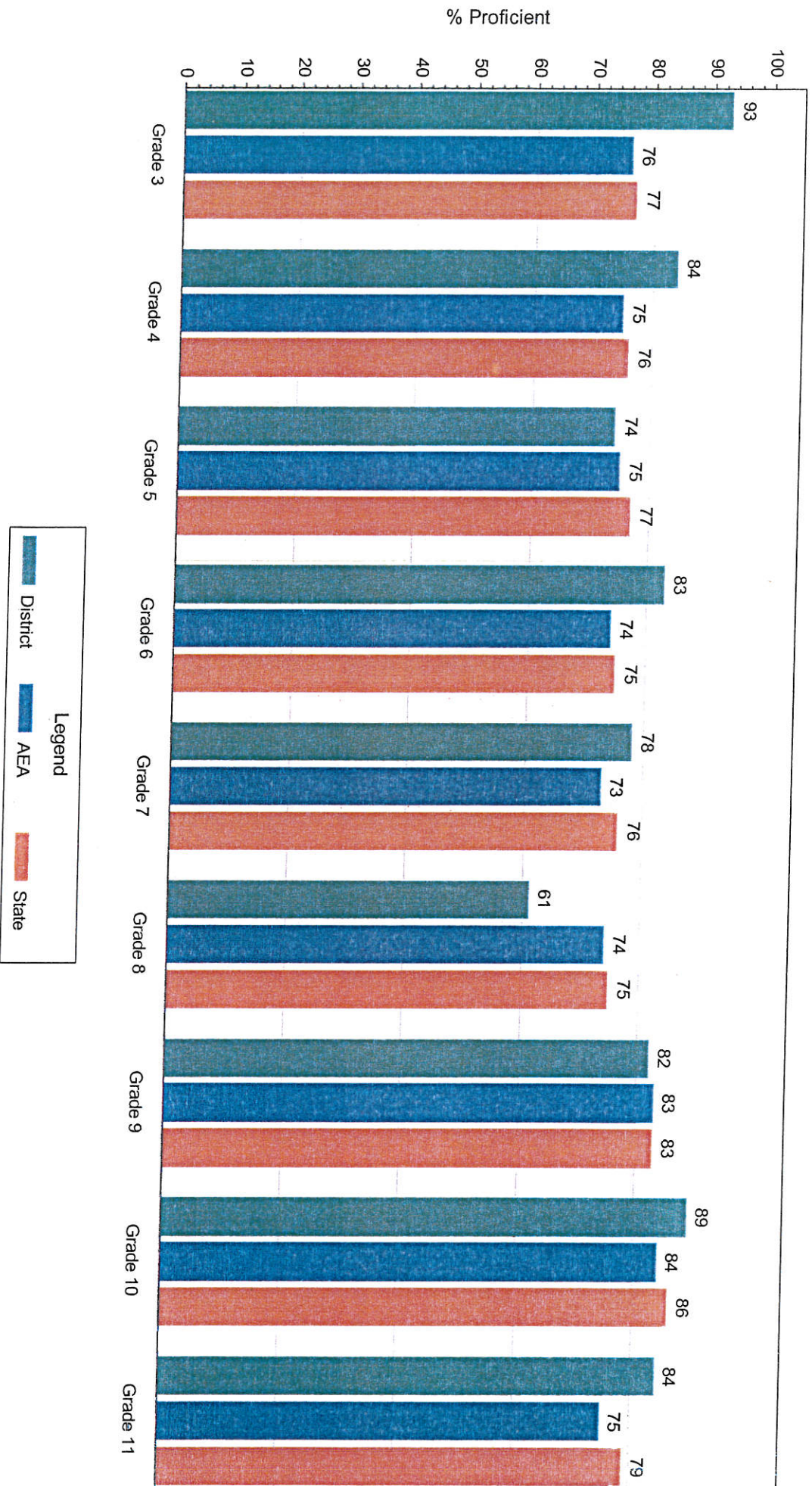

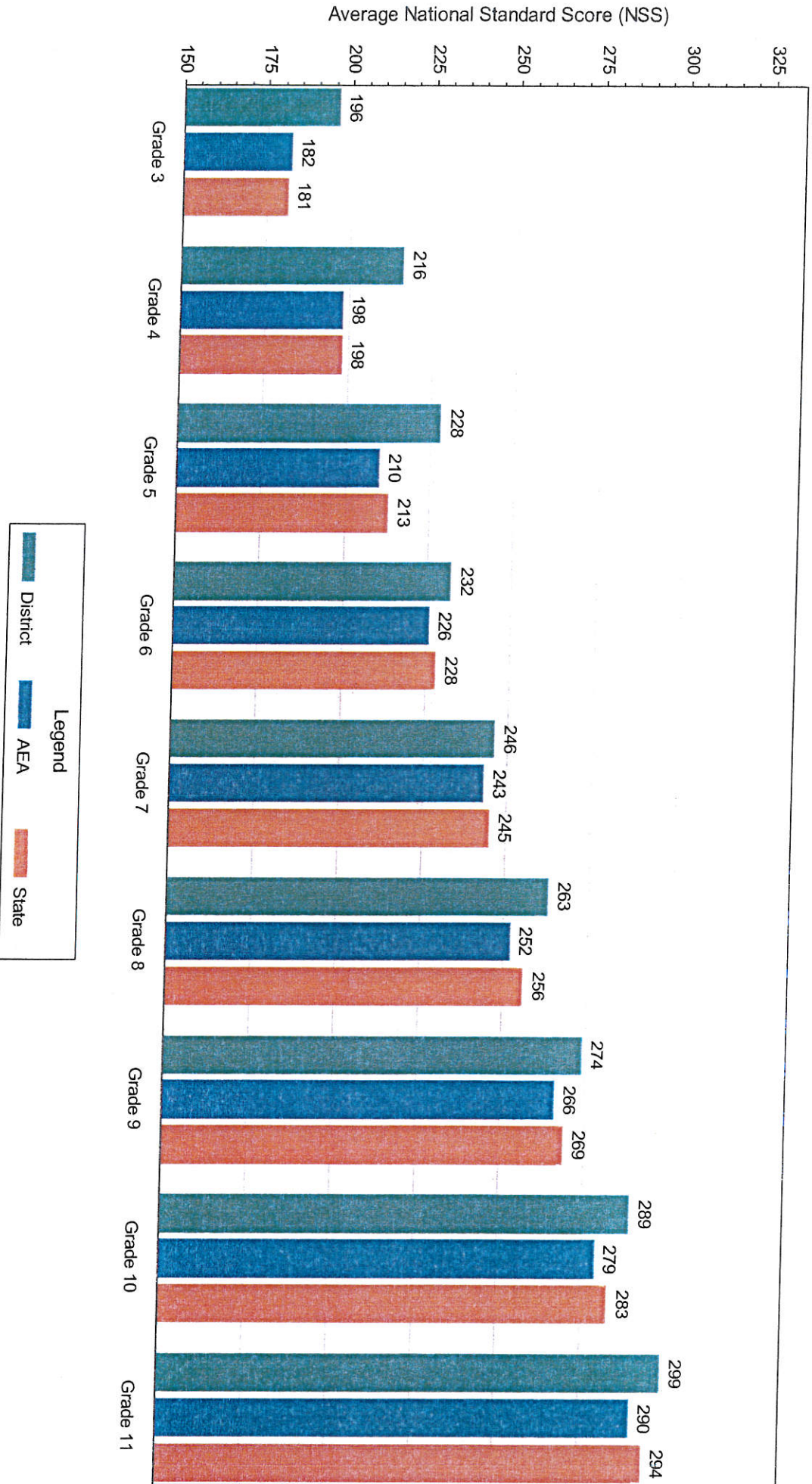

**Bellevue Community Schools: 2016-2017**



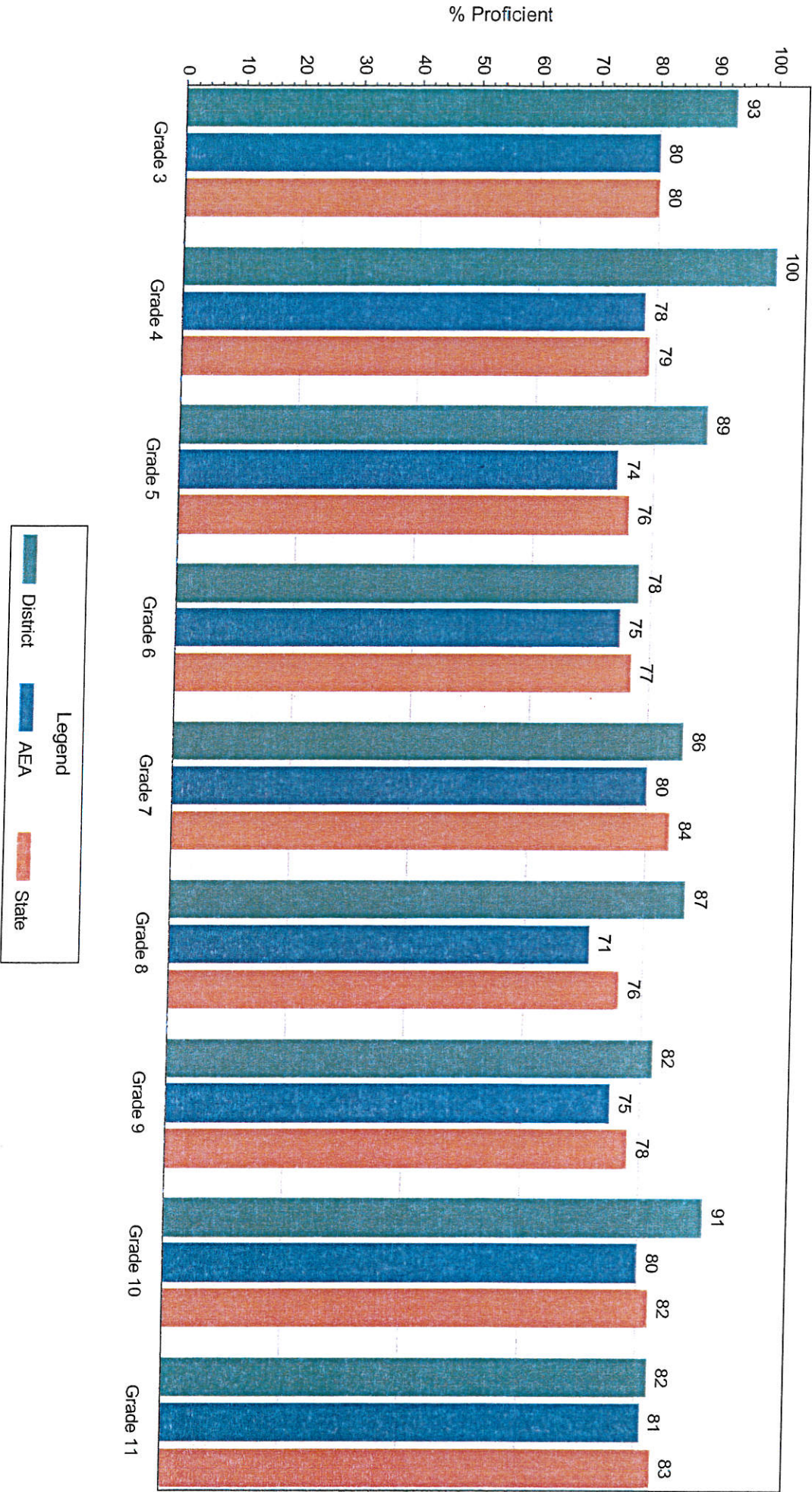

**Bellevue Community Schools: 2016-2017**



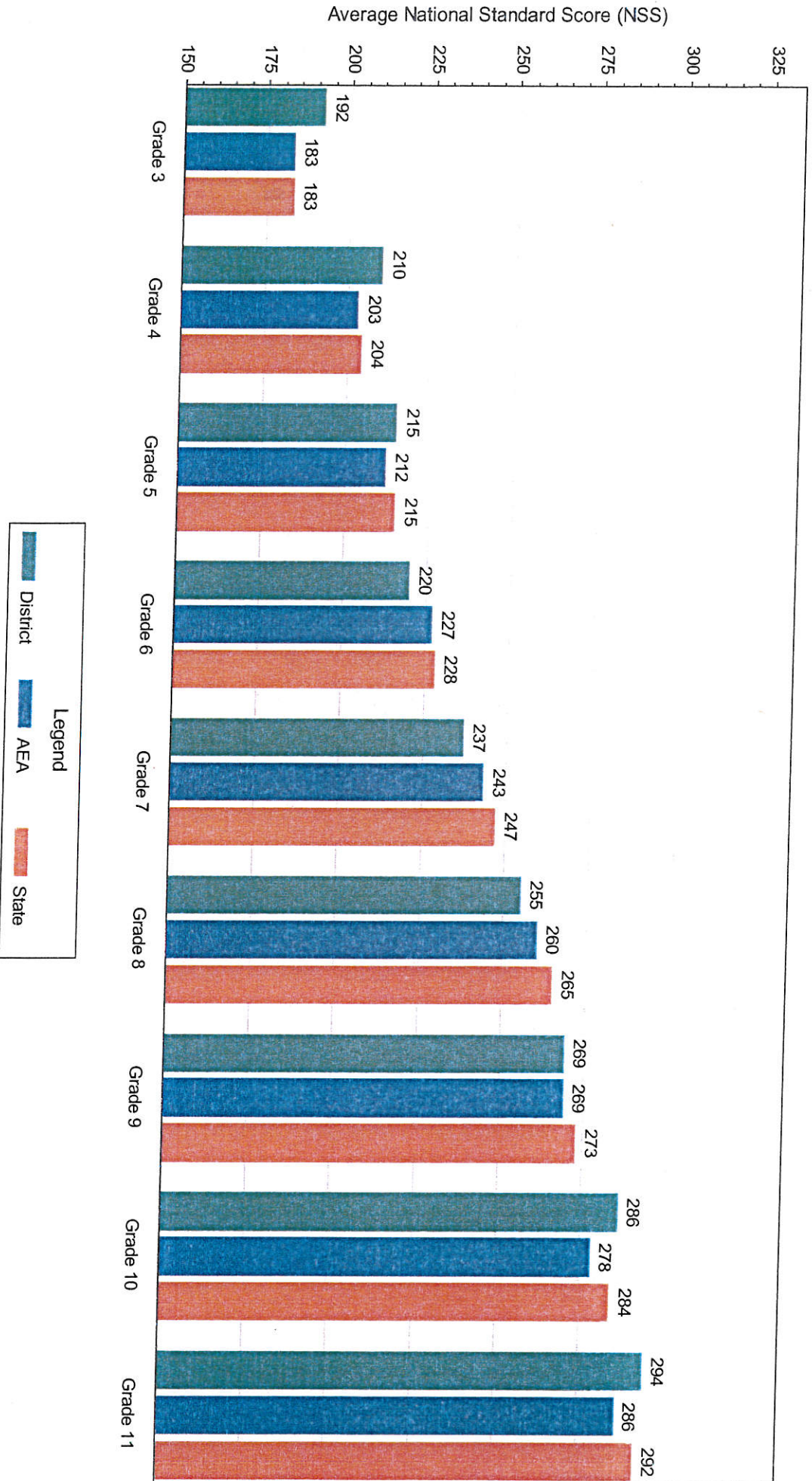

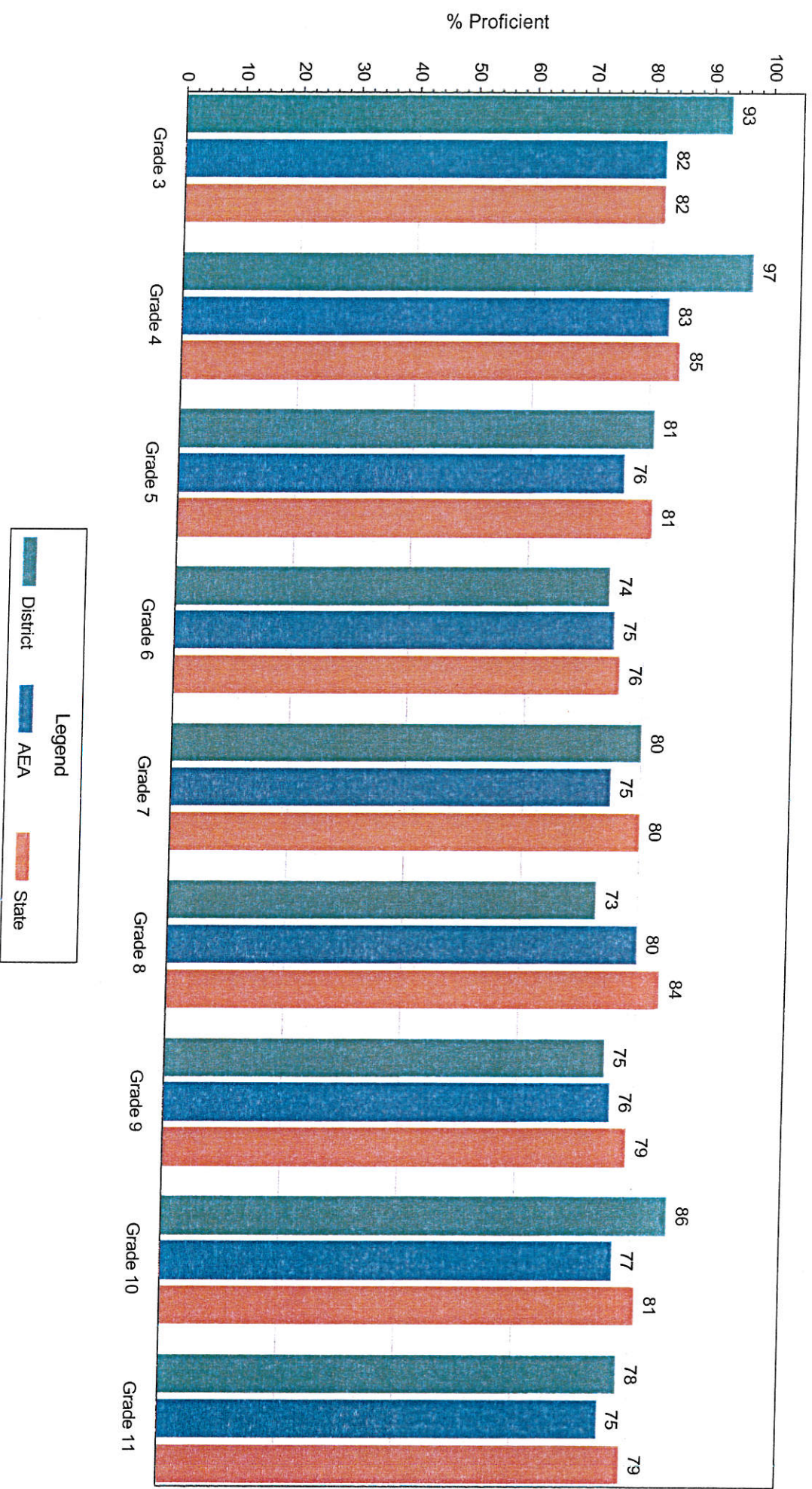
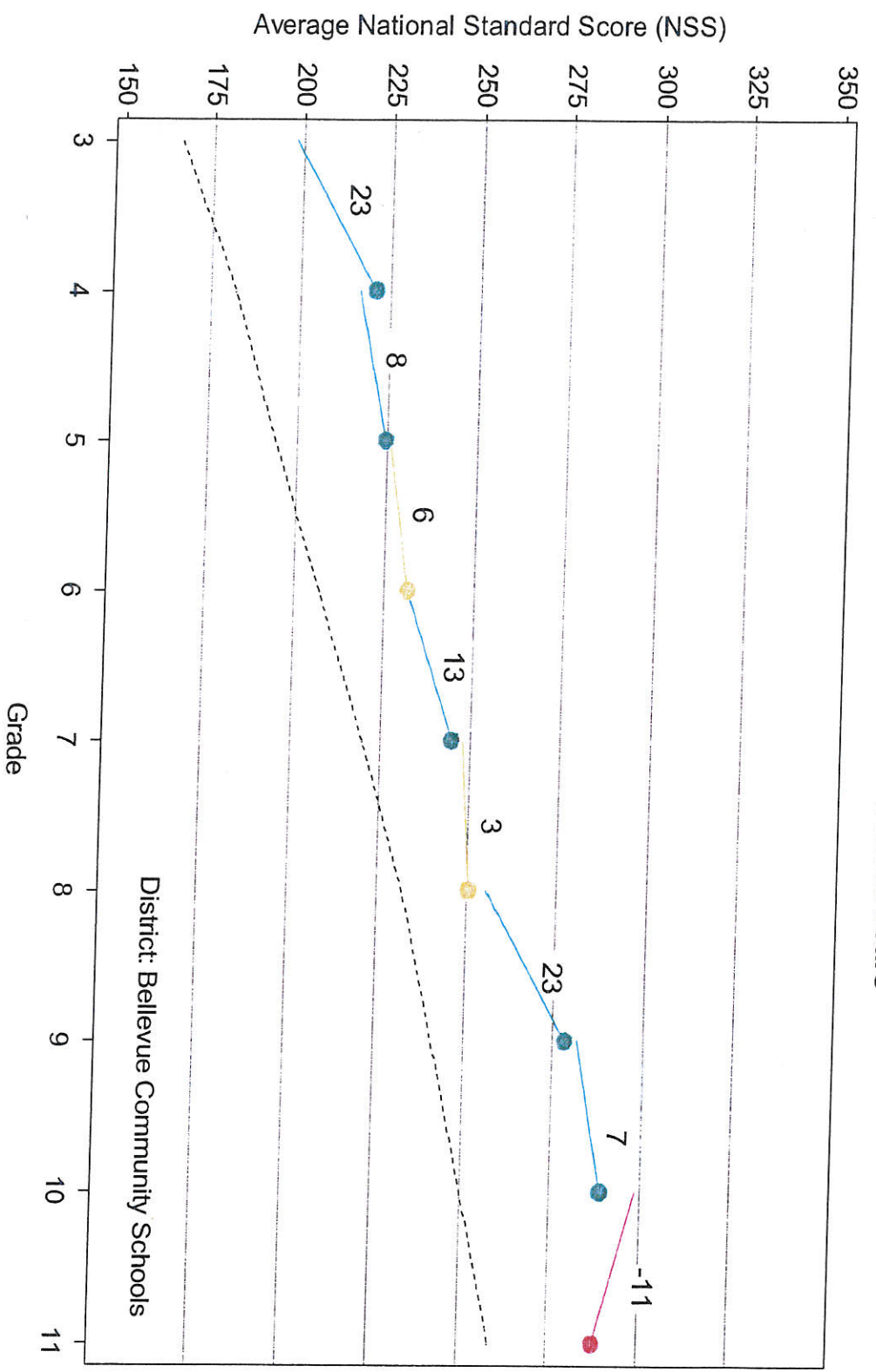


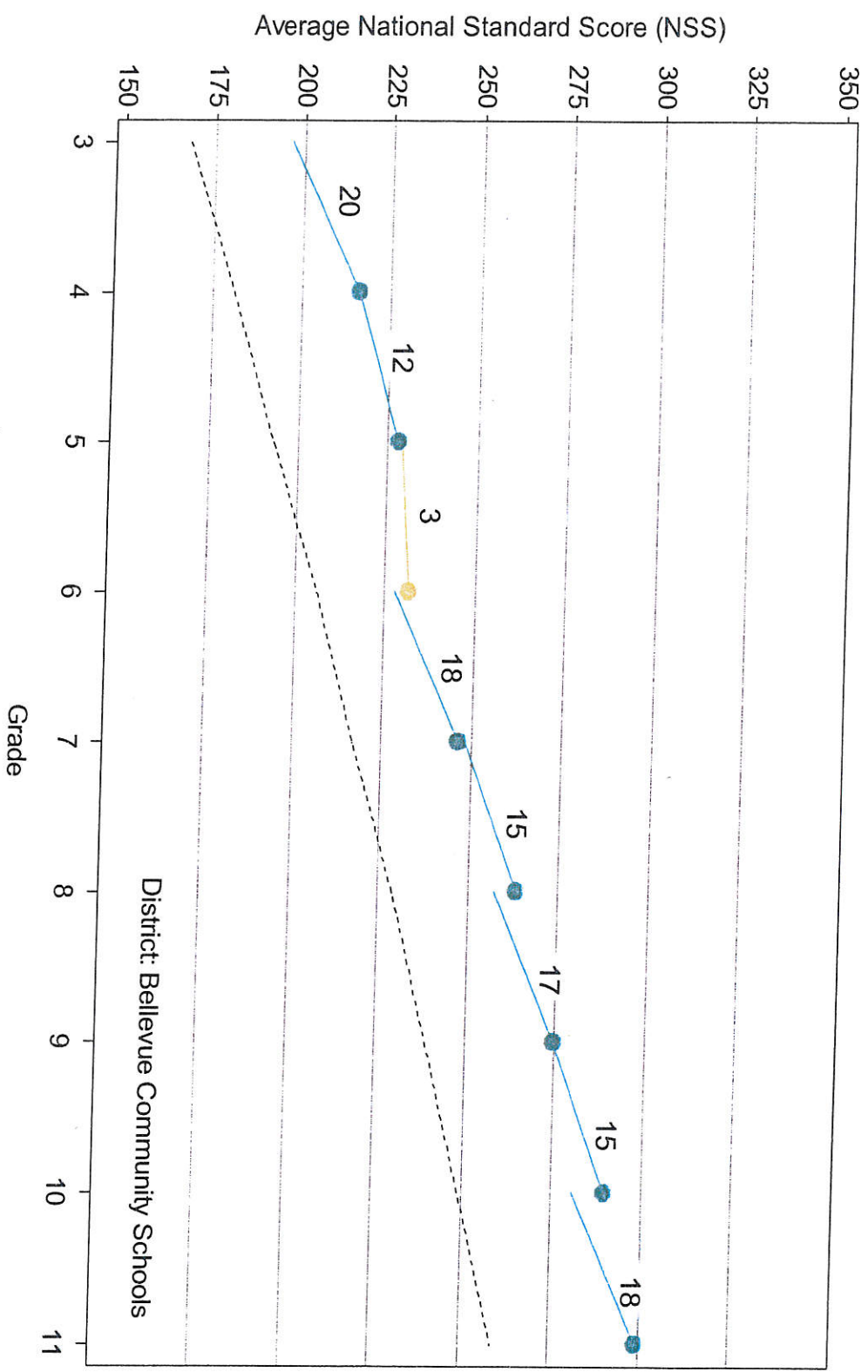

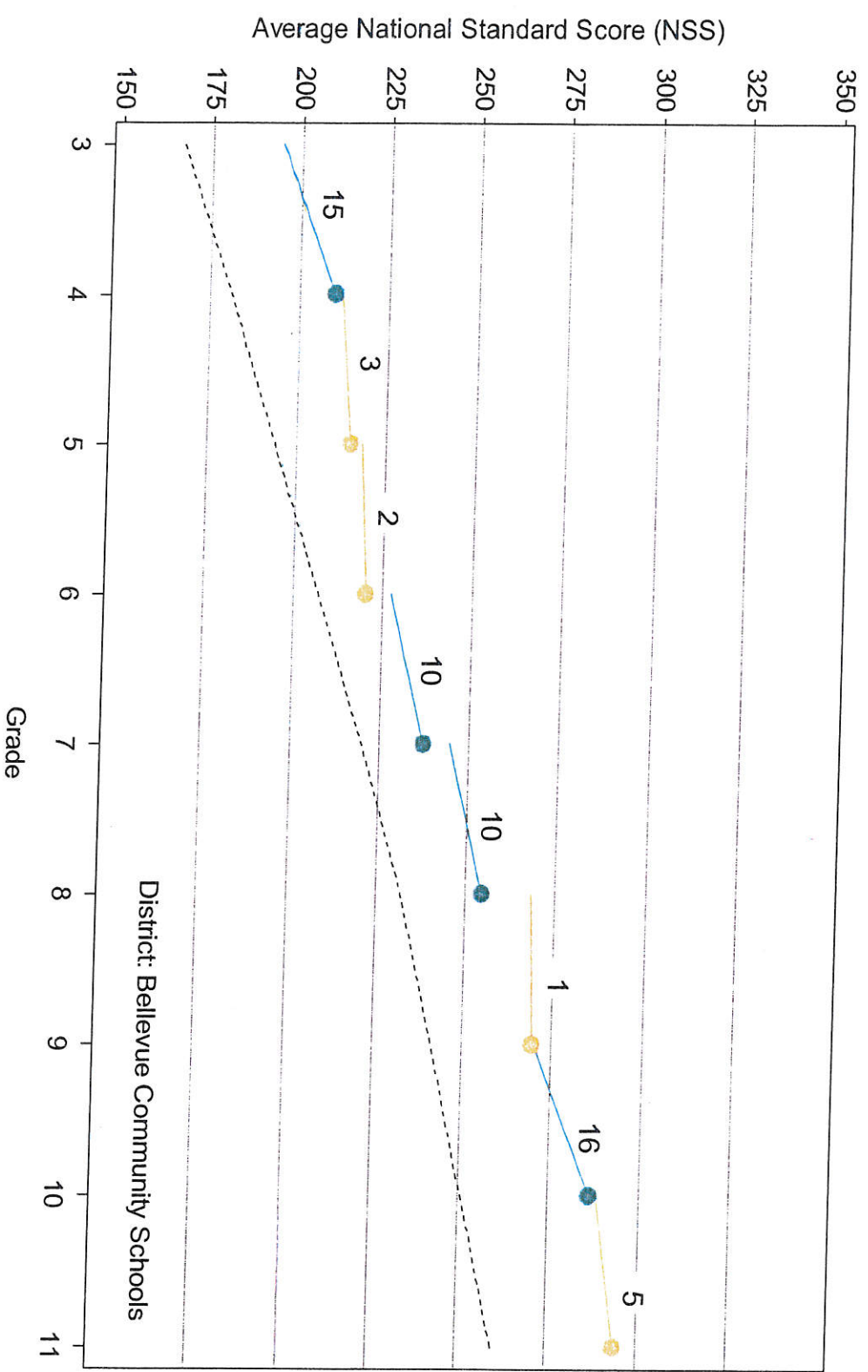
