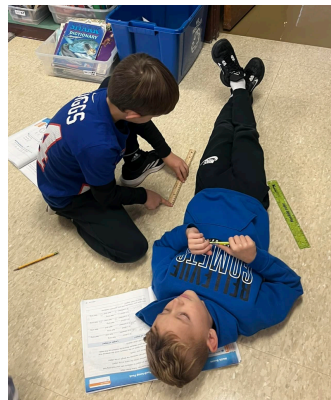
New Board Members & Election of Officers
