Bellevue CSD Referendum Information

While I mentioned the upcoming vote for a 3-5 elementary building last week, it is important to know what is different this time in comparison to the vote in 2018 and 2019:

WHAT'S DIFFERENT THIS TIME?

Following the last two bendvotes the district and community based committee wertback to the drawing board to come up with a plan that responded to community concerne. The final plan is a phased approach that costs less (despite current inflation) and will less on the impact on property taxes.

+ Phased Approach

Phase 1 (Bond-Hunded)

- Grades PK-2 stoy in the existing elementary school
- . Grades 3-5 move to a new building at the middle/high school s to

Phase 2 (District-Funded)

- Renovations and improvements to the high school's fine arts and CTE spaces
- Other facility projects to address space needs based on erroliment, including a potential addition to the S-5 building for FK-2

+ Lower project cost

\$13.1 m lion compared to \$16 million (2018) and \$14.5 million (2019)

+ Less property tax impact

- \$2.70 per #1 000 of property tox valuation compared to #4.06 (2016) and #3 76 (2019)
- The project cost will be supplemented by PPEL and SAVE funds which will not raise property taxes additionally
