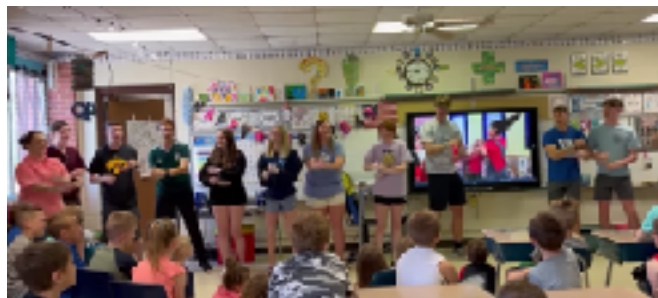
### State Track and Field
