This month the highlighted group is the **Comet Athletic Boosters.** This group is in the process of some reorganization, and is seeking more input and involvement from parents and others. The next meeting is on Wednesday, November 3 at 6:00 PM at Bellevue Middle/High School, and YOU are encouraged to attend. To share information, I am using the format of "Did YOU Know?" below:

- •The Comet Athletic Boosters **purchase all jerseys/uniforms** for athletic teams 7-12 for the Bellevue CSD on a scheduled rotation equal for all teams.
- •The Comet Athletic Boosters contribute approximately **\$5000-\$6000 to complete** an annual rotation of jerseys and uniforms for all participants.
- •The Comet Athletic Boosters make **donations toward high-cost items** like scoreboards, batting cages, and other things in coordination with the athletic department and the school district.
- •The Comet Athletic Boosters operate the **concession stand at all athletic events** all year long, and parents of students involved in athletic activities are the main source of workers for the concession stand.
- •All profits from the concession stand and fundraisers by the Comet Athletic Boosters are used for **student athletic programs** in the Bellevue Community School District.
- •The Comet Boosters are a 501(c)(3) organization **donations are tax-deductible.**
- •All parents of students involved in athletic activities (listed below) are part of the Comet Athletic Boosters and are welcomed and encouraged to attend Comet Athletic Booster Meetings and participate in activities.
- •Comet Athletic Boosters meet bi-monthly on the first Wednesday of the month. The next meeting is on November 3 at Bellevue Middle/High School at 6:00 PM.
