

Bellevue CSD Elementary Library Syllabus

1. Elementary Library classes @ BCSD focus on the [Iowa School Library Standards](#) and the implementation of those standards in weekly classes. The objective being that students will apply the information in other classes and daily life.
2. Primary Standards Covered:
 - a. TL 1 - supports the reading life of students and addresses inquiry, information literacy, and digital literacy
 - b. TL 2 - catalyst in igniting a passion for reading in every student and creating a culture of literacy in the school.
 - c. TL 3 - teaches a systematic approach to inquiry and the skills that support information literacy
 - d. LM 3 - provides experiences with and access to a current and diverse collection of resources, fiction and nonfiction, print and digital, to support student and curriculum needs
3. Units Taught:
 - a. Inquiry/Research
 - i. Information & Digital Literacy
 - b. Digital Citizenship
 - c. Diverse Literature
 - d. Non-Fiction Texts
 - e. Fiction Genres
4. Learning Measurements - daily checks for understanding and formative assessments that TL completes during classes with students. Grades are not given for Library class at the elementary level.
5. Technology Use - Elementary students utilize iPads or Chromebooks for access to:
 - a. MBEA One Click - database access
 - b. BCSD Library website
 - c. Google tools for inquiry presentations
 - d. Access to ebooks (via AEA databases) for reading
